Hence the reason ordained Presbyterian minister, author and School of the Pilgrim director the Rev. Brett Webb-Mitchell tells why he's risked being defrocked to publish his latest book, *On Being a Gay Parent*. "I wanted to align my life to a core of consistency....

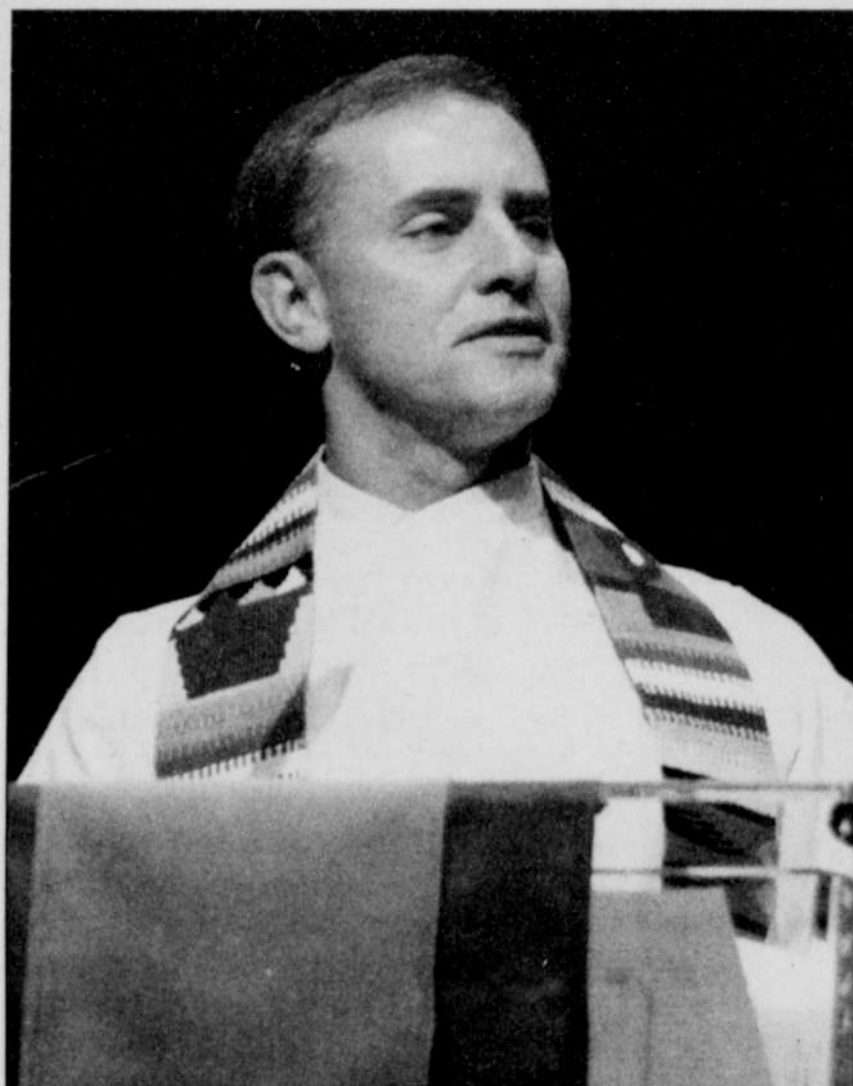
[The church] lacks a real-ness the world craves. By living our lives as real as possible, we can change the world one life at a time."



After coming out at 40 as a gay man, Webb-Mitchell divorced his wife and lost his tenure-track professorship at Duke Divinity School. He didn't, however, lose touch with his two children. He and his wife, on good terms to this day, decided on joint custody. And Webb-Mitchell embarked on a life he'd never expected, namely being a pro-gay, pro-family, pro-Christian father raising his two kids with the help of his ex-wife and current partner.

In his book, Webb-Mitchell discusses how to come out to your entire family, including your kids. He talks about how to navigate the often awkward situations of school, holidays and the parents of your kids' friends. He suggests creating your own unique household and addresses some of the latest legal battles.

Webb-Mitchell encourages us to create change by being educators everywhere we go. He under-
