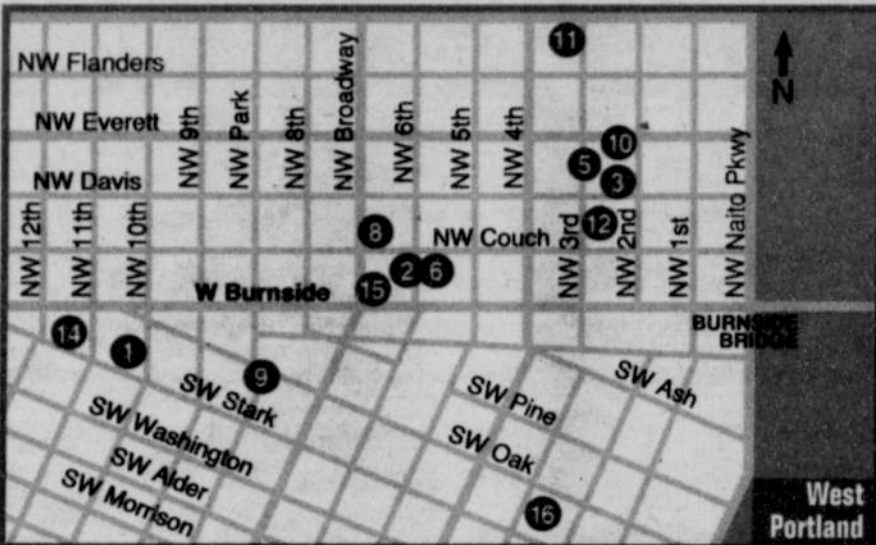
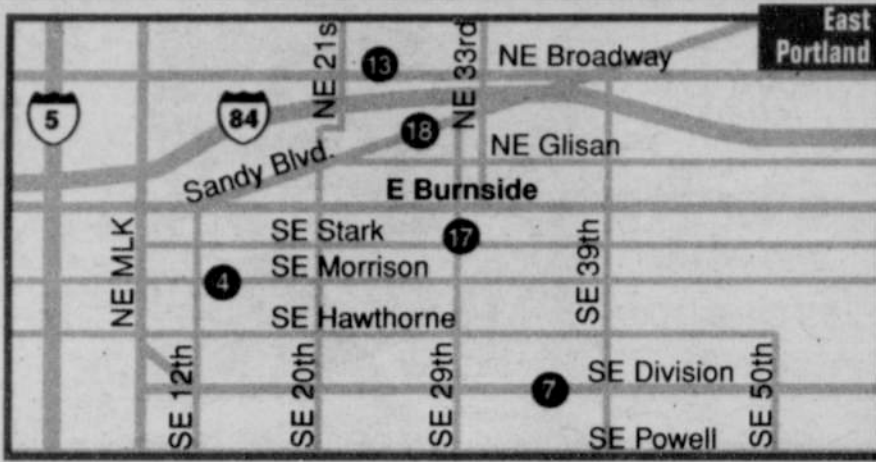

"Of course, everyone gets to put their clothes back on when they are done, and no one is required to get completely naked," reassures *Sister Mona Little-Moore*. "If someone is shy, we can offer them a token to represent their underwear to bet with."

The fun begins 4 p.m. March 9 at C.C. Slaughters, 219 N.W. Davis St. Admission is \$20, and the proceeds will benefit the Sisters' Grant Fund. "It will also help us start a scholarship fund for at-risk youth and hopefully enough to create a fund to send HIV-positive kids to Camp Starlight each year," Sister Mona says.

Next up the Sisters will host their third annual *Rotten Easter Egg Hunt* 4 p.m. March 30 at Embers Avenue, 110 N.W. Broadway. (Yeah, it's a week after Easter, which is why those eggs will probably be rotten.) Inside the eggs hidden around the club, participants might find treats or other items like toys or coupons for nice prizes, including two tickets to any performance this season at Portland Center Stage. The suggested donation is \$5, and proceeds benefit Camp Starlight, a weeklong residential camp that provides children whose lives have been affected by

Another big upcoming event is scheduled for April 6, when *Sister Bingo* comes to Portland. Bingo has been a big tradition for the Sisters around the world, and now it's here in the Rose City. "This isn't your grandma's bingo," warns Sister Mona, who encourages players to bring "your lucky troll doll and daubers" and promises "a wild time." Games start 4 p.m. on the first Sunday of every month at PPAA Hall, 618 S.E. Alder St. Admission is \$15 for a game pack and \$5 for each additional pack.
