



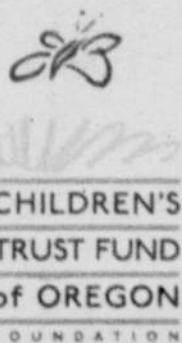

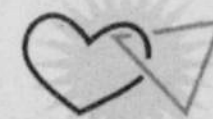

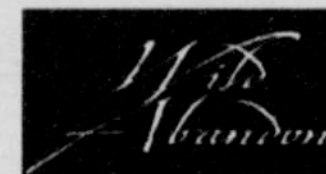

Under Marty Davis' leadership, Just Out has flourished over the past 10 years - a particularly challenging time for the print media, especially the gay press. In addition to the continued publication of a biweekly news magazine that has received national attention for its political and cultural content, Just Out has more than doubled its readership with a popular Web site and blog, which are updated daily.

For Just Out's first 15 years, the tenacity and perseverance of a core group of individuals created an institution: Renee LaChance, Jay Brown, Rupert Kinnard, E. Ann Hinds, Linda Kliewer, Kelly Bryan, Meg Grace, Eve Sicular, Ariel Waterwoman, Marvin Moore, Philip Anderson, Roger Hall, and many many others.

Under the guidance of the co-founders, Renee LaChance and Jay Brown, Just Out was the first lesbian and gay paper to get press credentials to the National Democratic Convention in 1988. The first queer publication to rely on non-gay businesses for advertising. The first to strive for equal coverage of gay men and lesbians. The first to buy a billboard for Coming Out Day that said: "Come Out, Come Out, Whoever You Are!" All this before the hate-filled Ballot Measures 9 and 13 put Oregon in the national spotlight.

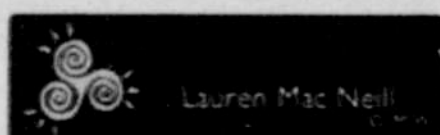
