The Dance Diva Is Coming to Town

When thinking of dance superstars, names like Madonna, Britney and Janet come to mind; however, it is **Kristine W** who is the ultimate dance diva. With 11 consecutive No. 1 hits on the *Billboard* dance charts, Kristine holds the record.

Hailing from Pasco, Wash., Kristine has always been a natural entertainer. The former Miss Washington spent years in the late '80s and into the '90s performing with her band in Las Vegas lounges and eventually received her own show at the Las Vegas Hilton. In 1994 Kristine signed with RCA Records and landed her first No. 1 hit with the dance anthem "Feel What You Want."

She then followed with her first album, 1996's *Land of the Living*, which made a huge splash in dance clubs—especially with queers, who have always been some of her most loyal supporters. "I feel so blessed and happy to be part of the community and to be able to watch everything change and progress for the better," Kristine says.

For the past 15 years she has continually released mega dance singles and

albums, including the hit "Some Lovin'," which was a featured single on the Showtime series *Queer as Folk*. This year Kristine is busy not only touring the nation but also planning the release of two albums. The first, titled *Power of Music*, is her fourth dance album. The second, *Straight Up with a Twist*, will showcase a different side of the artist: "I am taking some of my biggest hits and remaking them with a more jazz and Latin influence. It is a different vibe that I think people will enjoy."

Kristine's fans will have the chance to hear her latest work along with a few classics when she visits Portland this month. Crush will host a meet-and-greet and video release party featuring DJ Ja-

son Wann from 9 to 11 p.m. Aug. 15 as a benefit for Camp Starlight. The next day Kristine will be the headlining entertainer for **Block Party 2008** at C.C. Slaughters.

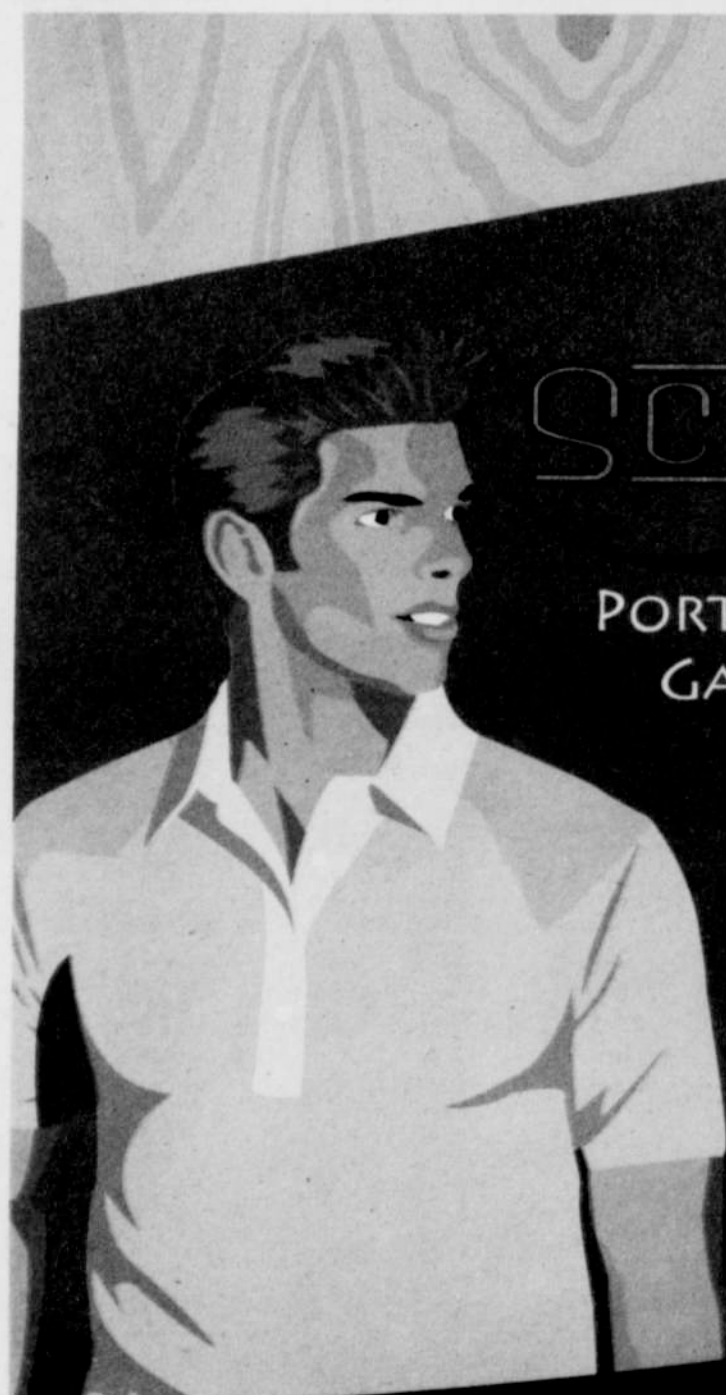
"I cannot wait to come back to Portland," she says. "I am bringing the entire band with me and know it will be such a fun performance!"

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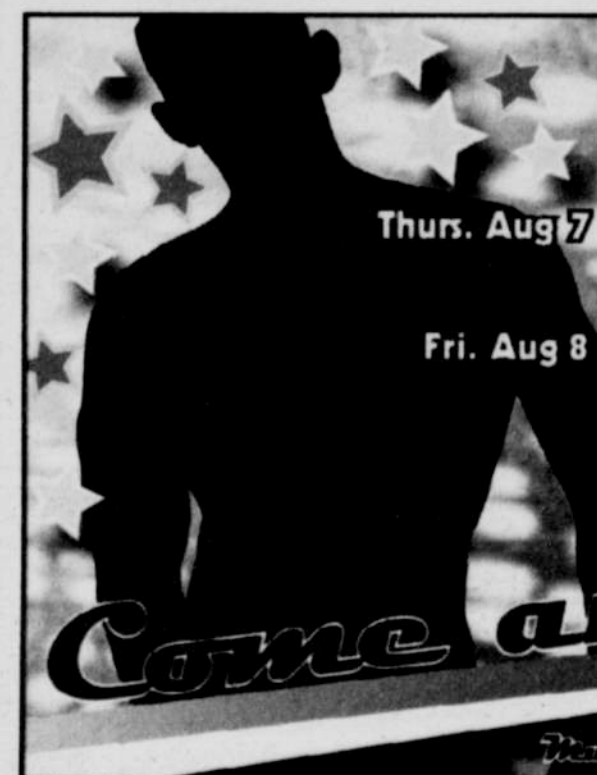
