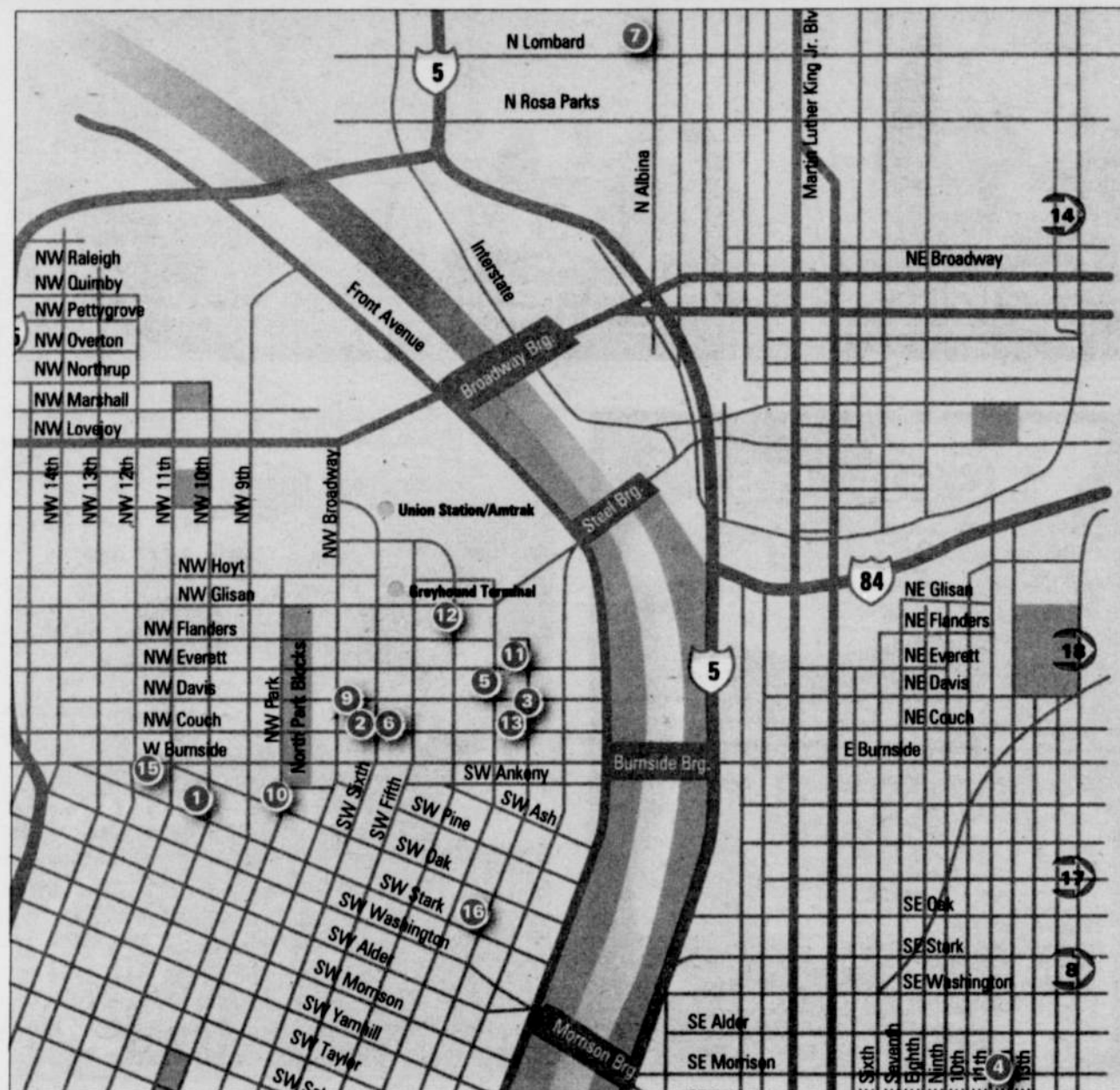

Sketchy, in a Good Way

Life drawing is no longer the exclusive province of bored, jaded art students.

The good folks behind two hip local events—Dr. Sketchy's and Sluts & Squares—have teamed up for an event called Query that asks the question, "Why can't life drawing be sexy?" The double event, taking place the night of Nov. 6, will combine DJs, go-go dancers, theatrical make-up, artwork, life models, "debauchery-laden burlesque dancers and stunning drag queens" in one glamorous swirl of homo-positive energy.

Zoe Moreno, the art director of Dr. Sketchy's Portland, says her goal in organizing Query is "to bring more personality to life drawing." The 24-year-old is a burlesque performer herself (under the name Violeta D'Posey) and met DJ BigTrak, the mastermind behind Sluts & Squares, while go-go dancing for that event, formerly held at Rotture. Moreno took over as art director of Dr. Sketchy's PDX around the same time that the former event lost its venue and fizzled.

"The three gentlemen behind Sluts & Squares have always been very queer-friendly, so when I took over the art direction of Dr. Sketchy's, it made sense to work in tandem with them," she explains. "So Query is really a double relaunch party for both events." One that she hopes will become a regular monthly occurrence.

Dr. Sketchy's is not unique to Portland. It was started in 2005 by artist and entrepreneur Molly Crabapple in Brooklyn as a burlesque show featuring drawing contests during breaks. The "Dr. Sketchy Anti-Art School" has since garnered coverage in major media outlets throughout the world; today, there are at least 50 Dr. Sketchy groups in 11 countries on four continents. Par-

ticipants are referred to as "art monkeys," while models are said to be well paid for their services.

For the Nov. 6 event, photography will be allowed and art supplies provided for those wishing to draw who come unprepared. Query will feature the auditory satisfaction of three DJs, four cabaret life models (two male, two female) and the artwork of Jimmy Tovar.

The party starts 9:30 p.m. at the Crown Room, 205 N.W. Fourth Ave. Free cover until 11 p.m., \$3 after. For more information visit www.myspace.com/drsketchiesportland.
