Keeping the Bad Habit

Dressing up for Sundays doesn't require your best suit or cutest dress when you're acting up with the **Portland Sisters of Perpetual Indulgence**. Quite the opposite, really. Next month's **Sister Bingo** theme is "Dirty Circus Bingo," so expect a carnival of queer folks from 4 to 7 p.m. Feb. 8 at PPAA Hall, 618 S.E. Alder St.

"It's not your grandma's bingo," says Sister Dixie Rupt.

Last month's "Hawaiian Bingo" got more than 70 people "lei'd," raising money for the Sisters' grant fund, which will donate the proceeds back into the queer community through organizations such as Camp Starlight, Oregon AIDS/LifeCycle and the Sexual Minority Youth Resource Center. The \$15 admission will buy bingo players one ticket for all 11 games, while high rollers can throw down \$20 for two bingo cards a game.

"Everyone gets a 'Free Shit' raffle ticket and could buy a 50/50 raffle ticket," Dixie says. Raffle winners can choose a prize from the "Free Shit" table, with gifts ranging from CDs to candles to toys. Gambling types can buy a 50/50 raffle ticket for a cash prize that's split in

half with the winners and the Sisters. "We also have a Wheel of Torture that we spin every time someone calls a wrong bingo for public humiliation. They might have to do a sexy reading from a cookbook, walk a runway or sing 'I'm a Little Teapot.'"

In addition to Sister Bingo, C.C. Slaughters will be hosting the third annual **Angels of Portland** 9 p.m. Jan. 24 at 219 N.W. Davis St. A \$5 donation will get patrons through the gates in a choir of drag seraphims and cherubs. The Sisters will reveal a newly elected Angel at the event. Active members of the sexual minorities community are christened by the Sisters as either Saints or Angels.

"Saints make contributions to the gay community of Portland, while Angels are important to the Sisters," says Sister Krissy Fiction. "For example, Bolivia Carmichaels is an Angel."

The main goals of the Sisters of Perpetual Indulgence are to increase love and decrease shame. "Our spirituality is bound to our service," Krissy says. "We have no religious affiliation."
