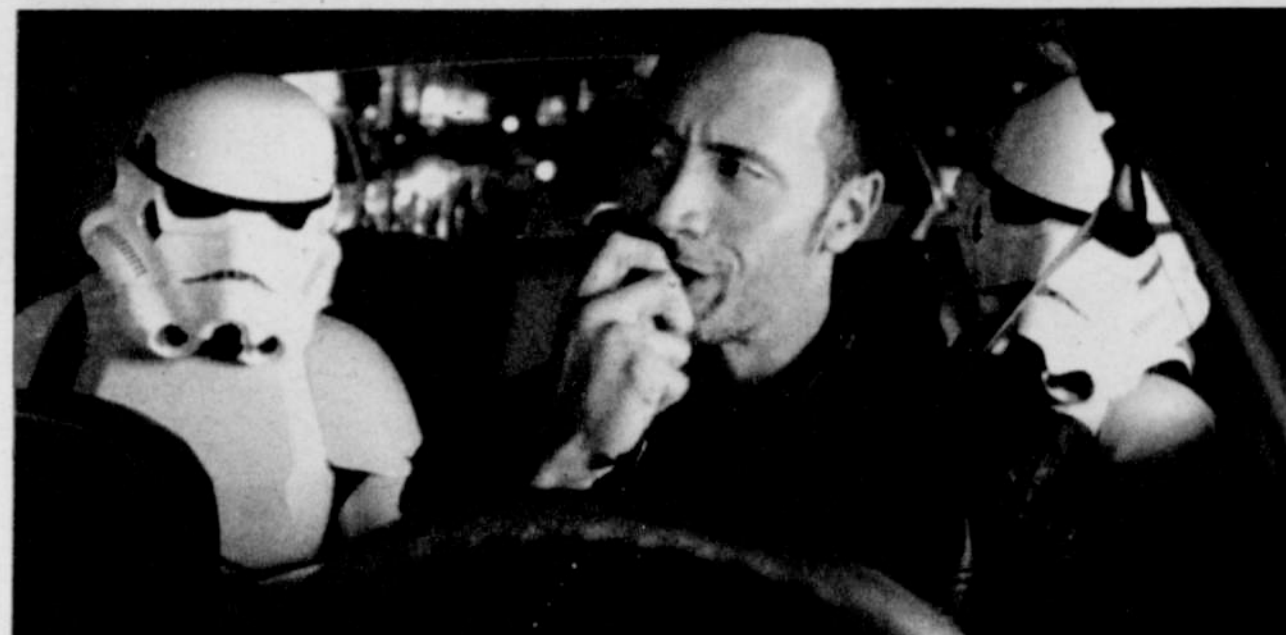
»Race to Witch Mountain
