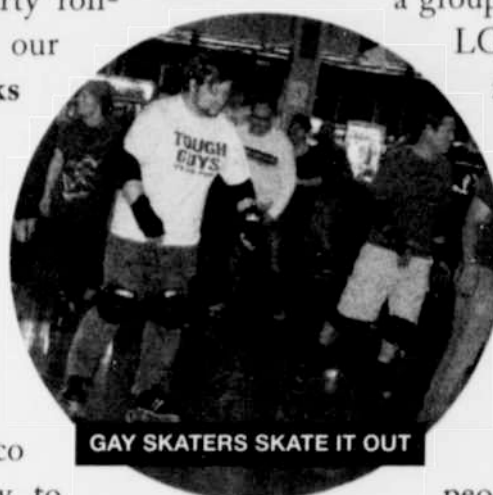

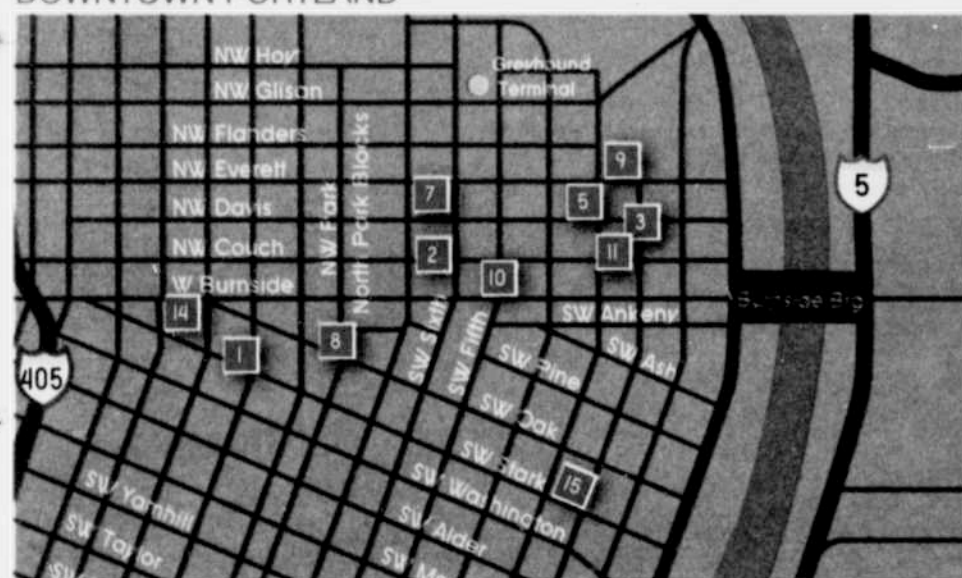
Pride 2011 isn't over until you take that last lap around the rink. If the wheels are on, so is the fun. **JO**

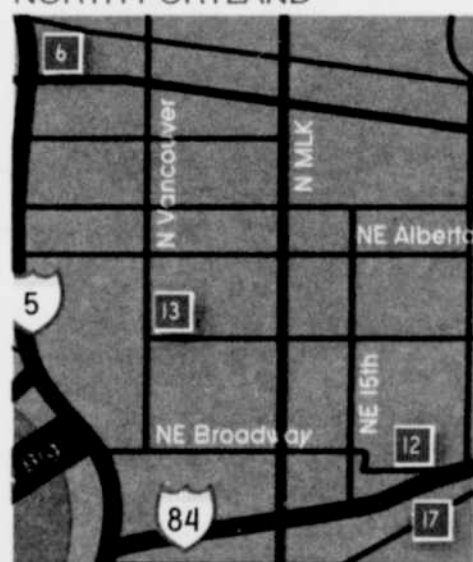
