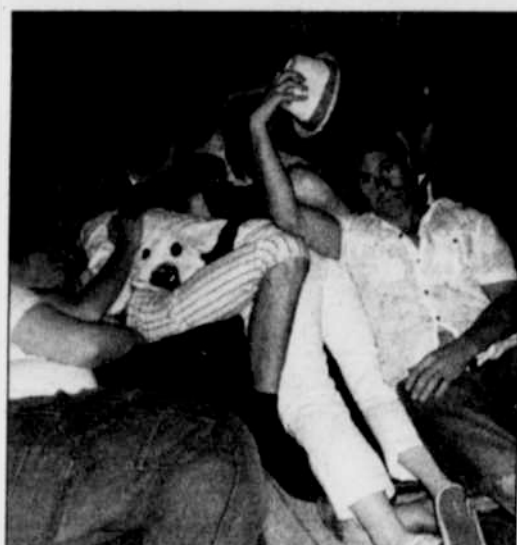

Stone Cold Beats

Feeling the dark and danceable world of Austra's Katie Stelmanis

With influences rooted in classical music as much as dance, pop and punk, Katie Stelmanis has a flair for the dramatic. Backed by bassist Dorian Wolf, drummer Maya Postepski and keyboardist Ryan Womsiak, Stelmanis' ethereal **Canadian quartet Austra** (her middle name) is garnering buzz to match as the next big thing from our neighbor to the north. The band performs with Cold Cave and Dangerous Boys Club July 22 at the Doug Fir.

On debut album *Feel It Break*, Stelmanis, who recently ranked on the Out 100, and Co. bring to mind The Knife, infused with a heavy, seedy dose of '80s British New Wave. Fans of Kate Bush will take to Austra's brooding mood music, which gets a studio assist from producer Damian Taylor (Bjork, The Prodigy, UNKLE), Stelmanis' quivering operatics and tinkly, glock-pop arrangements. Her choice of "most bizarre gig," as described in an *Oyster Magazine* interview, is a bit surprising then—"inside a cave in a very old part of Estonia." Austra's theatrically catchy approach seems perfectly suited to such confines.

And to the Doug Fir stage, where they'll perform with fellow electro-gothers Cold Cave and Dangerous Boy Club. Get ready to emote in the dark MIDI crannies of Austra's atmospherics.
