With Teeth

Profile Theatre opens 15th season with McNally's AIDS-era drama

For its season-opening play, Profile Theatre turns to Terrence McNally's *Lips Together, Teeth Apart*, a family portrait 24 hours—and a lifetime of baggage—in the making. Jane Unger directs Portland talents Susannah Mars, Leif Norby, Karen Wennstrom and Darius Pierce as a grieving sister, her husband and in-laws, respectively, each coming to terms with fear and love.

It's the Fourth of July, and Sally Truman is mourning the loss of her brother David to AIDS. Sally and husband Sam are spending the holiday weekend at the Fire Island beach house David shared with his lover—the house David left his sibling. Accompanied by Sam's sister and her own husband, Sally and her houseguests wrestle with their anxieties over the epidemic, homosexuality and their own relationships.

Needless to say, the ties that bind—marriage, blood

and otherwise—hit the deck in more ways than one. By juxtaposing the lives (and monologues) of its four straight leads with a houseful of (unseen) gay characters, McNally's 1991 play sparks fireworks of a whole different kind in an explosive, both heartbreaking and humorous look at identity.

And with Mars at the center of Profile's new production, audiences can be assured a powerhouse start to its 15th season, a trip down memory lane also set to include works by Edward Albee, Wendy Wasserstein, Lee Blessing and others.
