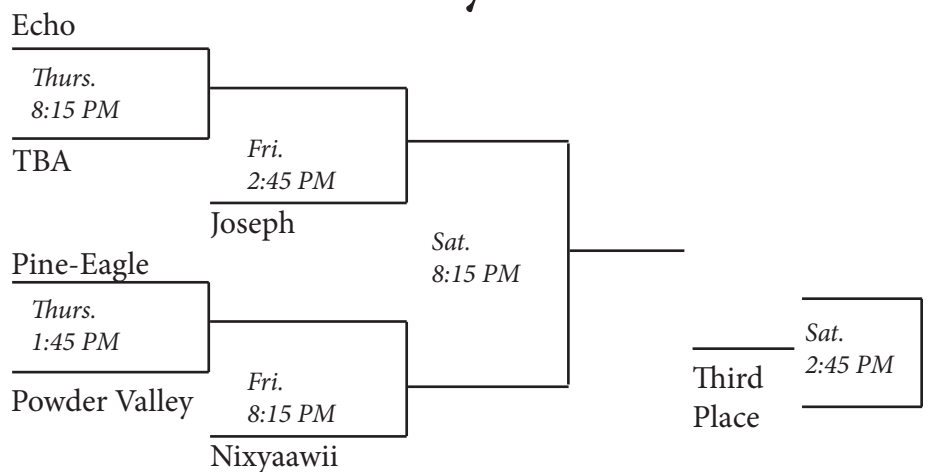

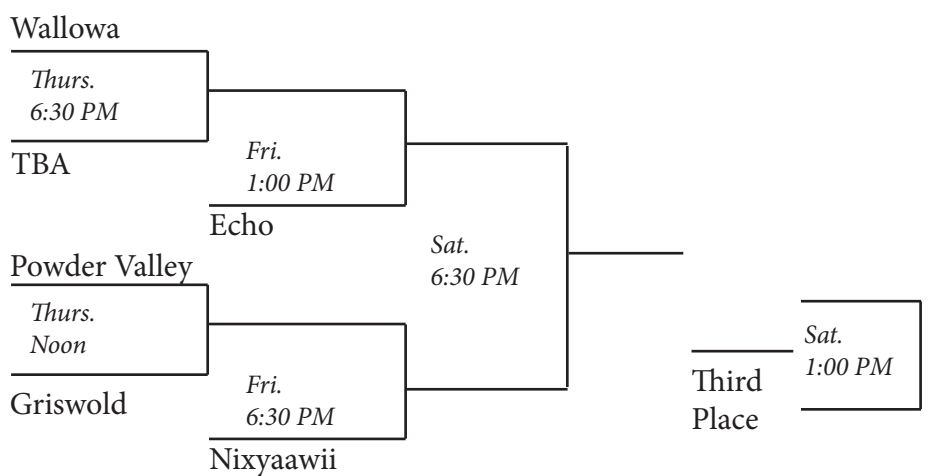

## BHS wrestling sets new school record

Baker Wrestling set a new school record Saturday with 10 wrestlers qualifying for state, the most ever sent by Baker to the state tournament. The old record set in 2003 was eight.

We also sent eight to state in 2010 my first year as head coach for the Bulldogs.

In the team race LaGrande and Baker just did not have enough numbers.

Ontario and Mac-Hi had several kids taking 5th or 6th place which adds up a lot of team points.

Ten out of our 12 kids finished in the top three of their weight class and we had one fourth, and one fifth. In a small tournament like this our only shot at winning is for most of our team to make the finals, which is a definite challenge.

Marco Vela was our lone champion pinning his way through the tournament! In the finals he had built a 7-0 lead when he got thrown to his back and was nearly pinned, but he fought out of it and was able to secure the fall later in the match and overcome the close call despite giving us all a couple of extra grey hairs.
