Local Lions Club donates glasses around the world

Members of the Baker City Lions Club met in February to sort and count hundreds of pairs of used eyeglasses, lenses and hearing aids to be distributed to needy people throughout the world.

About 700 pairs of glasses were collected from donation boxes located in businesses and

offices throughout Baker City. They were counted and sorted by type, including prescription, reading, and sunglasses. A small number of separate lenses and hearing aids were also collected.

The glasses and hearing aids were sent off for cleaning and restoration so they can be provided to

low income people in the United States and other countries.

Baker City Lions Club is a nonprofit organization devoted to community service projects as well as sight and hearing at the state, national and international levels.
