## DEQ fines City of Huntington

The Oregon Department of Environmental Quality has issued a \$1,275 penalty to the city of Huntington for exceeding permit limits for E. coli in effluent from its wastewater treatment facility.

The city exceeded E. coli limits in January 2015. Additionally, the city failed

to monitor for E. coli at least every two weeks, as required in its permit. DEQ also penalized the City of Huntington in 2009 for exceeding E. coli limits, and issued a warning letter for similar exceedances in March 2013. DEQ issued the penalty because exceeding effluent

limits threatens aquatic life and human health. E. coli is a bacteria that indicates fecal contamination with the possible presence of pathogens and the risk of disease.

The City of Huntington has until July 6, 2015 to appeal the penalty.

fish for them. Reedy gave them some gold and tips on where to spot elk. He said they rented the hotel for five days and the Elkhorn Saloon stayed open late to accommodate feeding the crew.

Reedy said the group next heads to Forks, WA (yes, of *Twilight* fame). The episode filmed there will be related to the logging industry.

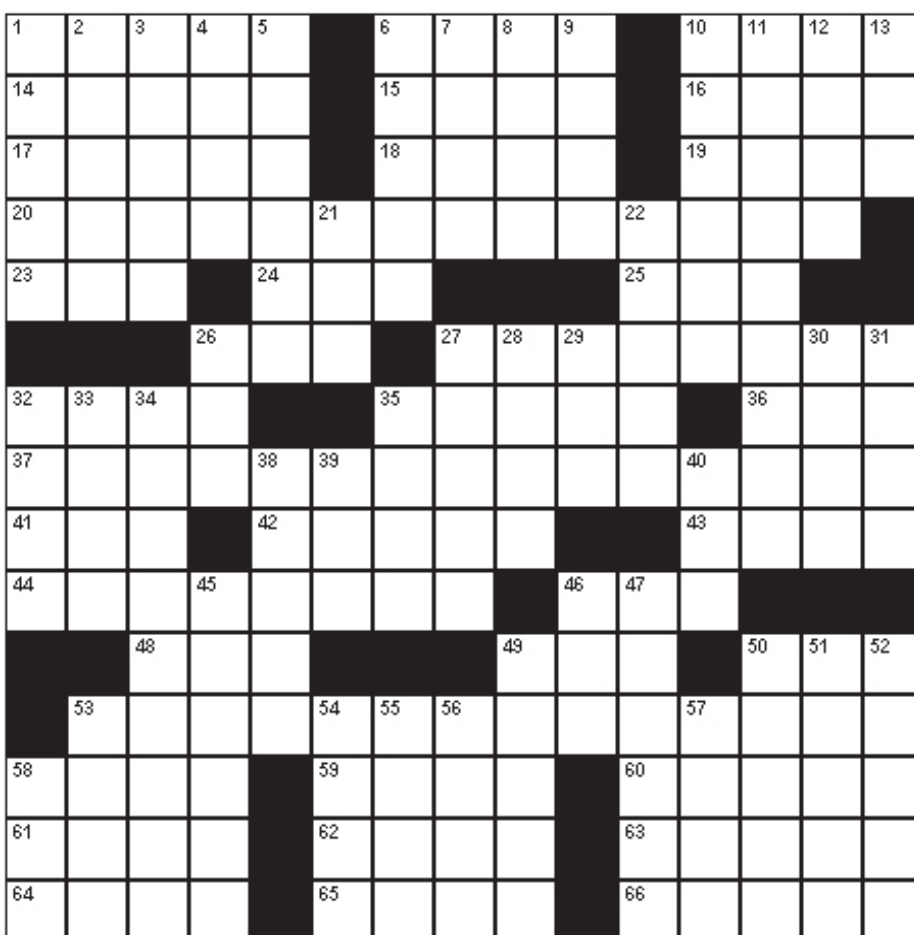

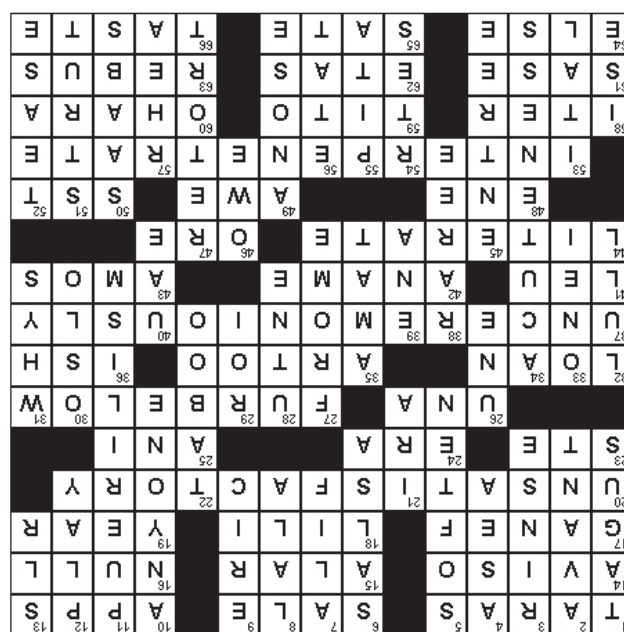
