For the 14-15 age group, Hunter Hill took 1st place, scoring a 99, with five bullseyes; Trenton Dowdy placed 2nd, also scoring a 99, with five bullseyes, after a shoot-off with Hill; Michael Morine placed 3rd, scoring a 99, with four bullseyes; Kayen Woodcock placed 4th, scoring a 99, with four
