Christina Witham, of Oregon Sign Company in Baker City, was recruited, per recommendations, to handle the graphics design work. "She does great work," Furtney said.

Furtney said Witham replicated graphics from original Basche-Sage Mall signs found in the basement of the building, and placed them on the glass of the double door entrance on Broadway. "They're beautiful," Furtney said.

For now, Batchelor said,

most of the interior work involves cleaning, moving appliances out, removing countertops, and determining what needs replacing, and what layout will be, with work paused until after Christmas and the New Year.

Furtney provided a teaser, regarding a mystery appliance, expected to be installed: "It's something very unique, and, very cool. It will be exciting, it will stir up interest," she said.

Furtney said that, with other businesses to run full-time, it's difficult to

find time to spend remodeling Charley's. "We're doing it as fast as we can, and, believe me, I want to be open," she said.

Furtney and Batchelor said they'd like to continue some of the traditions of Charley's, such as working with local fire and police departments to offer ice cream vouchers for children.

Furtney said, "That's our vision, too," about continuing traditions, and, being a big part of the community. The grand opening is expected long before next summer, she said.

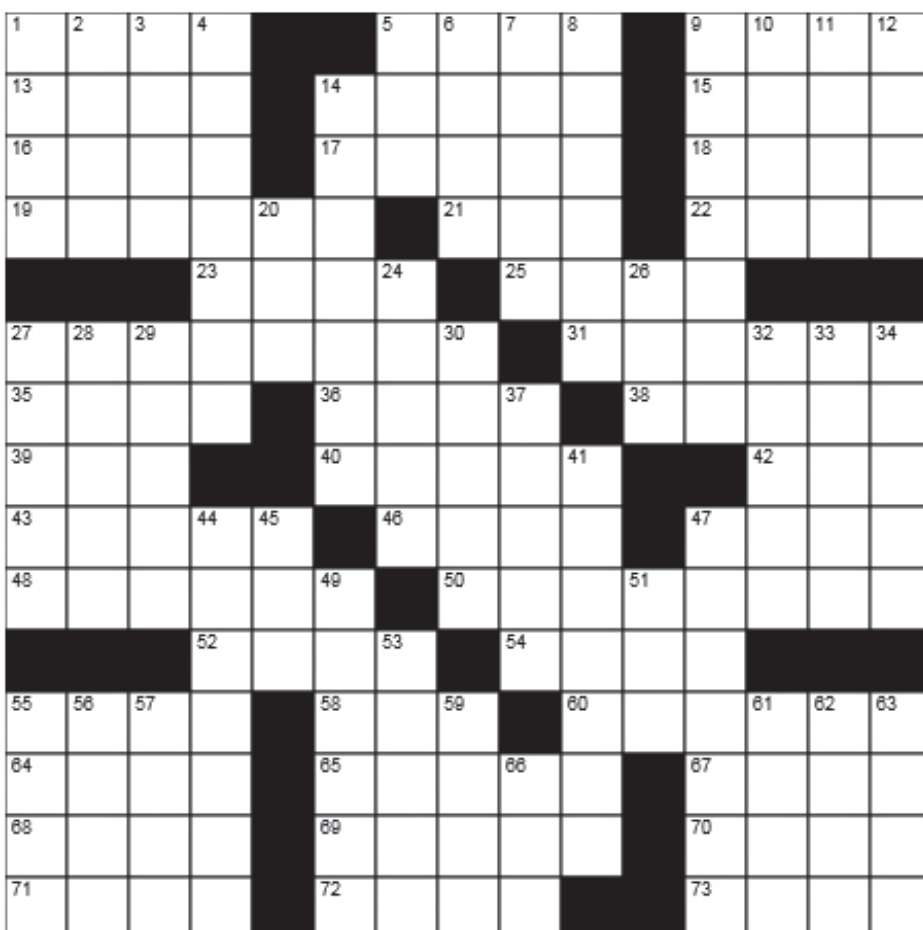

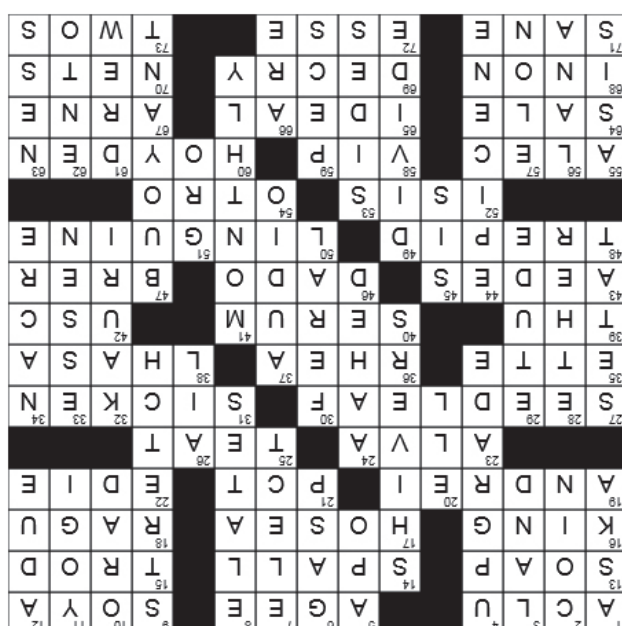
