## SEACT and NEACT meet Jan. 25 in John Day to review STIP Projects

Members of the North East Area Commissions on Transportation (NEACT) and the South East Area Commissions on Transportation (SEACT) will be meeting in John Day from 11:30 a.m. - 4 p.m. Pacific Time at the Grant County Regional Airport, 72000 Airport Road. The group will review proposed projects for the 2018-2021 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).

A separate meeting of the Governor's Transportation Vision will be held at the same location between 9 and 11:30 a.m.

An Area Commission on Transportation is an

advisory body chartered by the Oregon Transportation Commission to help address all aspects of transportation.

The North East Area Commission on Transportation is comprised of community leaders and other stakeholders from Morrow, Umatilla, Wallowa, Union and Baker Counties, as well as the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation.

The South East Area Commission on Transportation is comprised of community leaders and other stakeholders from Malheur, Grant and Harney counties, as well as the Burns-Paiute Tribe.

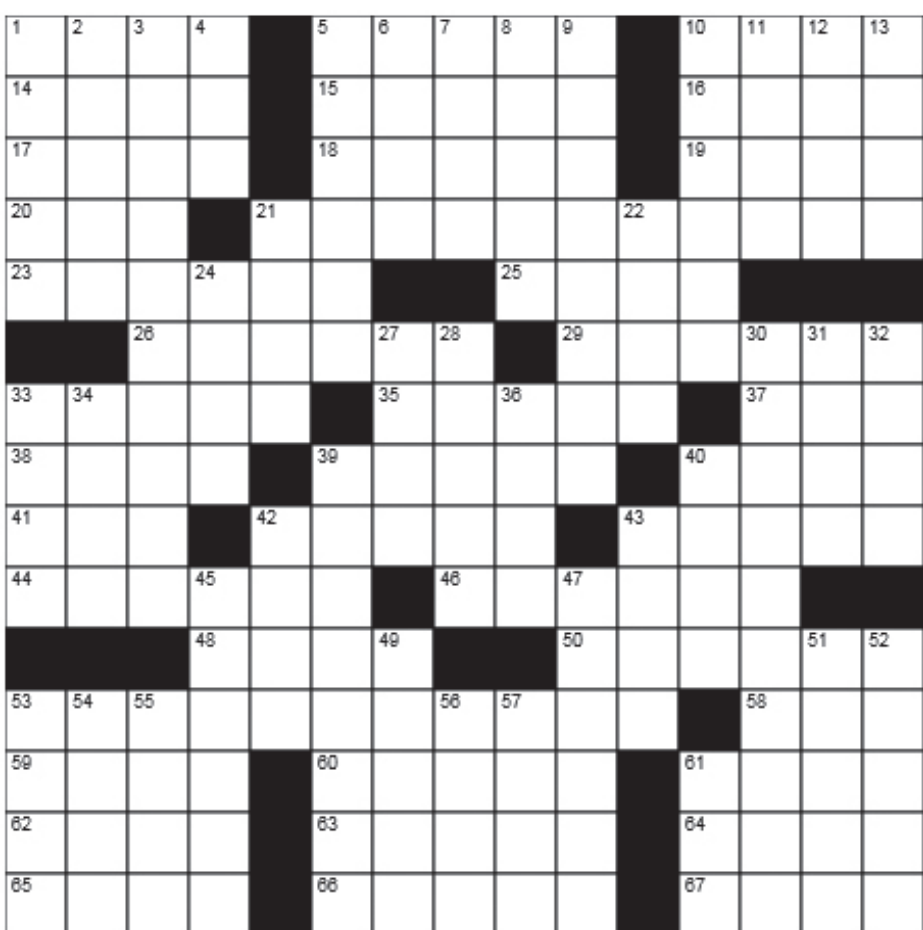
