"The bottom line, when you talk about the mission of Step Forward is service to people with disabilities and Step Forward just simply excels at that," said Button. "I'm sad to be retiring but by the same token, it's time for a new generation, it's time for a

younger sheriff to come in town. There's going to be a lot of battles to be fought. Some of the legislative stuff that's coming out of Salem now just makes you sick. We fought twenty plus years to help develop the rights and the freedoms for people with disabilities and then you see edicts coming out of Salem that wipe that away with the

stroke of a pen. And the new director, whoever he or she may end up to be, is going to have their work cut out for them. But I'm abundantly confident that we have the staff within Step Forward to deal with the future, to deal with the challenges, and continue to get the job done."

Harvey continued: "Share information with each other's staff, and have meetings, to discuss differences in plans, and consider alternatives which would reconcile proposed action with the County's laws, policies, and plans, and take all practical mea-

sures to resolve any conflict (consistency). This must be completed before going to public input."

Harvey continued: "Come to an agreement on plan of project, then bring plan to public for input. Make changes or adjustments to plan, after input from public and other government agencies."

Harvey continued: "Where mutually acceptable to local government and the Forest Service, coordination may be com-

pleted and documented by staff-to-staff communications, but final decisions rest with decision makers." He said, "That would be your upper echelon staff, and the Baker County Commissioners."

Montoya said, "I think a decision on the Forest Plan might rest with the Forester." Harvey said, "No. I disagree."

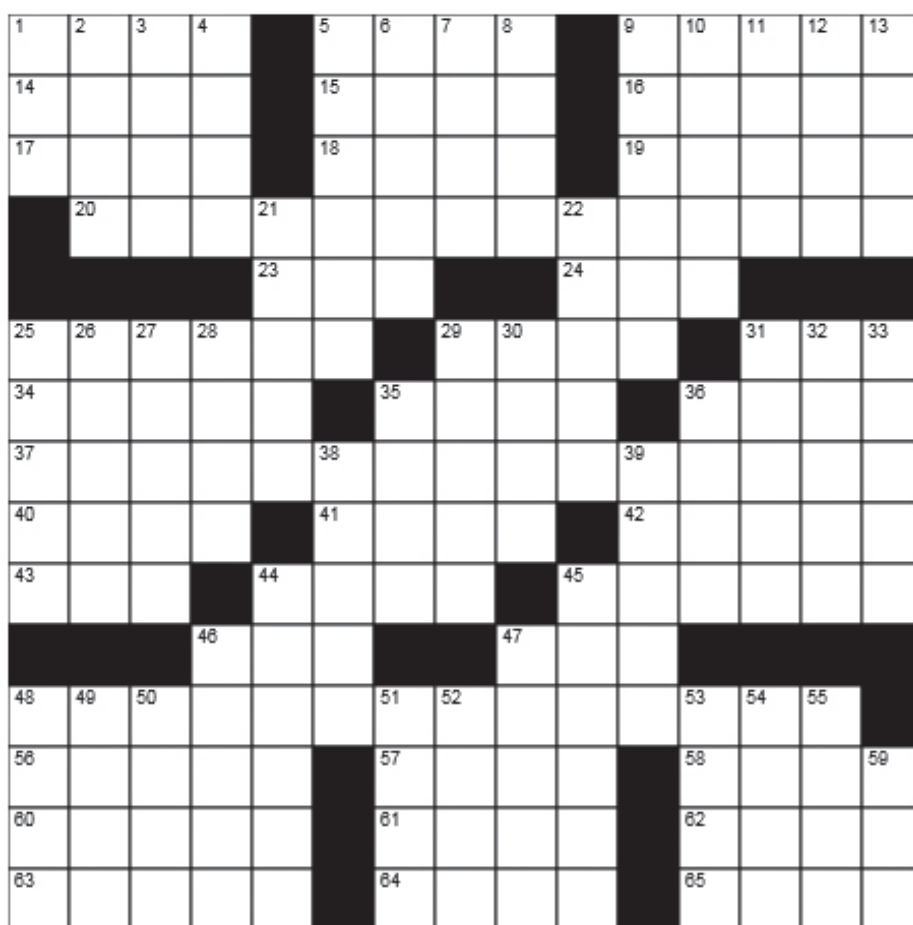
