Sumpter declares emergency

Last week Sumpter City Council declared an emergency, joining multiple other cities and counties across the State facing difficulties due to heavy

snowfall and extreme weather conditions. Mayor Cary Clarke explained that the heavier snow conditions this year have depleted funds for snow removal.

Clarke said that now that the Governor has declared

a State of Emergency in Oregon, the City may be able to access some government funds, though he emphasized nothing is guaranteed and receiving assistance is only a possibility.

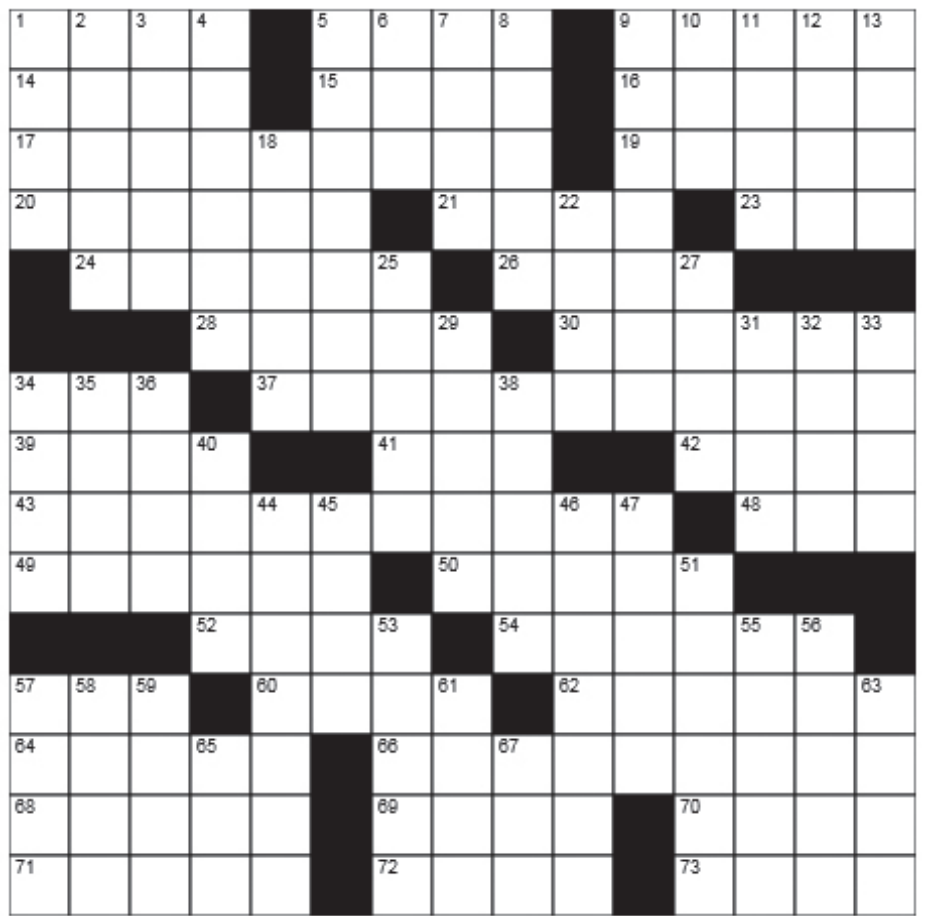
