That scenario could change, but there's no way to predict what will happen with the funding in the near future, without more information.

The County Road Department's budget is one of the major concerns for the County, and with SRS (Secure Rural Schools) funding halted, and the future of PILT funding uncertain, this will be a continuing discussion.

After further discussion regarding concerns about the 2017-2018 budget, the Board decided to schedule a work session for Wednesday, April 19, 2017, 1:30 p.m., in order to continue the Board discussion. The Board also scheduled the first County Budget Board hearing for Wednesday, May 3, 2017.
