
## A FRIENDLY ECLIPSE REMINDER ..


The time the eclipse will last through totality = 2 minutes, 40 seconds


The time it takes to *total* your car and *totally* change the lives of your family, friends, and innocent strangers from distracted driving = 5 seconds

Don't text and drive during this eclipse event or ever—it is totally not worth it!










