In October of 2006 he stepped in as Mayor until January of 2007. He also served as vice Mayor from 2009 to 2011.

Sam was best known for the Christmas light display at the Bass residence. Sam and his family decorated for the community for at least thirty years, with hundreds of decorations, if it didn't move there was a light on it. There has been at least four generations of community members visiting the display. Sam would be out in a Santa hat greeting the people walking through the yard filled with thousands of Christmas lights and characters cut out of plywood along with cute store bought decorations they bought at the end of the holiday season usually on sale.

On August 23, 2017, Sam felt ill so he drove himself to the emergency room where he was later

transported by Life Flight to St. Alphonsus Hospital in Boise, Idaho. He spent five days in the Intensive Care Unit and passed away on August 28, 2017. This was the fifth time Sam was transported to a Boise Hospital but he was not able to overcome his heart issues this time.

Sam was preceded in death by his daughter, Karen Bass, his parents, Jack Homer and Ruby Morgan Bass, and in-laws Frank and Lily Colton.

Sam is survived by his wife, Nora Colton Bass, daughter Sharon Bass, his son Jack Jr and his wife Tisha. Grandchildren John and his wife Rebecca Aguirre, Kayce Bass with her companion Jay Gursky, Michael (Scott) Tugman, Samantha Tugman and her companion Paul Hunt, Lilly Bass, great grand daughter, Izabell, and his cat Dini.

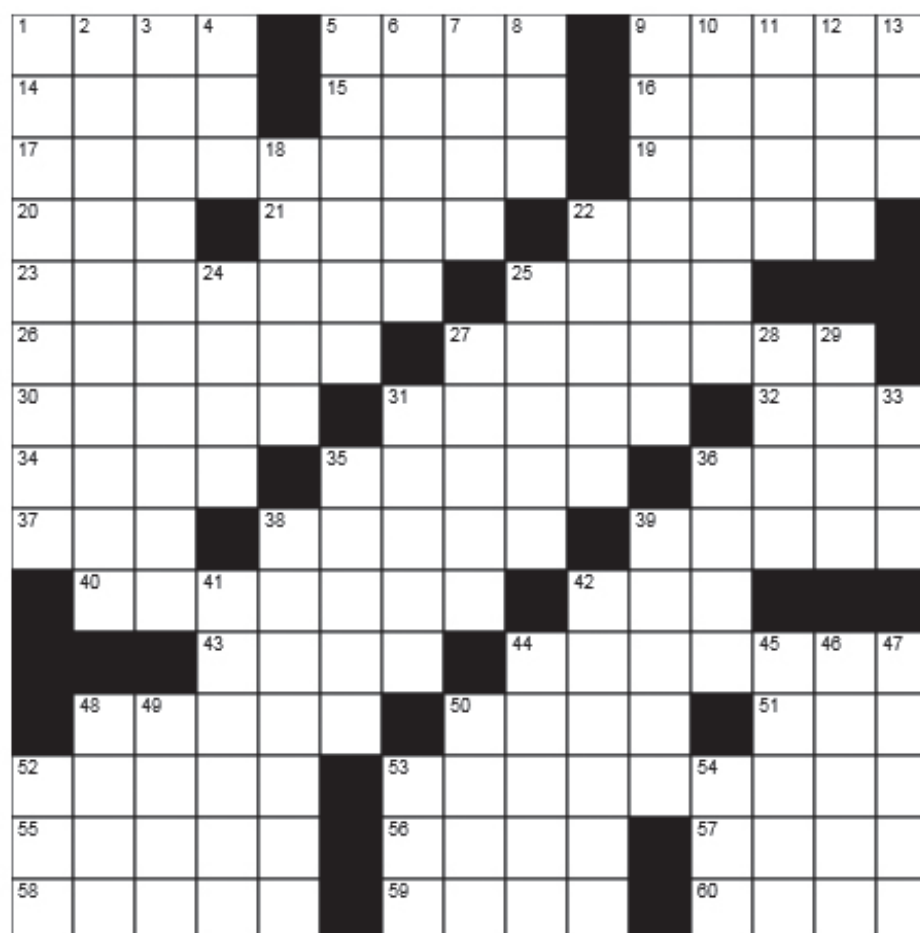
