Ball explained that people should “buy from replicable vendors, purchase regulated mods this will help ensure safety. Know the output/volts of your device and the capabilities of your device. Read the owner’s manual and follow the directions. Never leave your vape in the car. Heat can cause them to explode. Use care with batteries. Once purchased, get a demonstration of how your device works. Never carry batteries in pockets or mix with change or car keys; this will avoid exploding batteries. Educate yourself on the care of Lithium batteries. If a battery can’t

vent, it will explode.” Shepherd said they have a GoFundMe Account to help pay for dental bills.

“This is hard for us as business owners as we take safety very seriously and work very hard to inform

our customers of the care and safety of their electronic devices,” explained Ball. “Proper care and learning how to use these devices is so important. Building coils is another extremely important mes-

sage we want to make. Know what your battery can withstand if you do build.

“This hits close to home and we are praying for the young man for a speedy recovery.”
