### Spencer Dorway

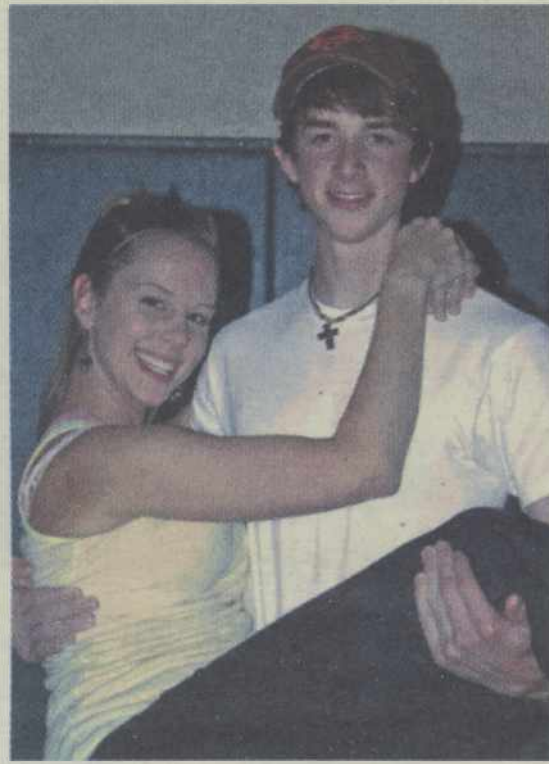
*If you were voting, who would you vote for and why?*

### Seth Wheeler

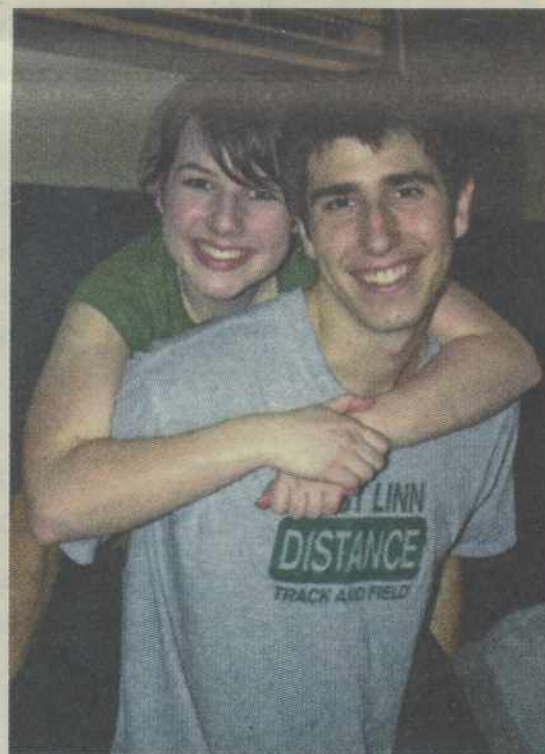
*If you were voting, who would you vote for and why?*

*If you were a shoe, what shoe would you be?*

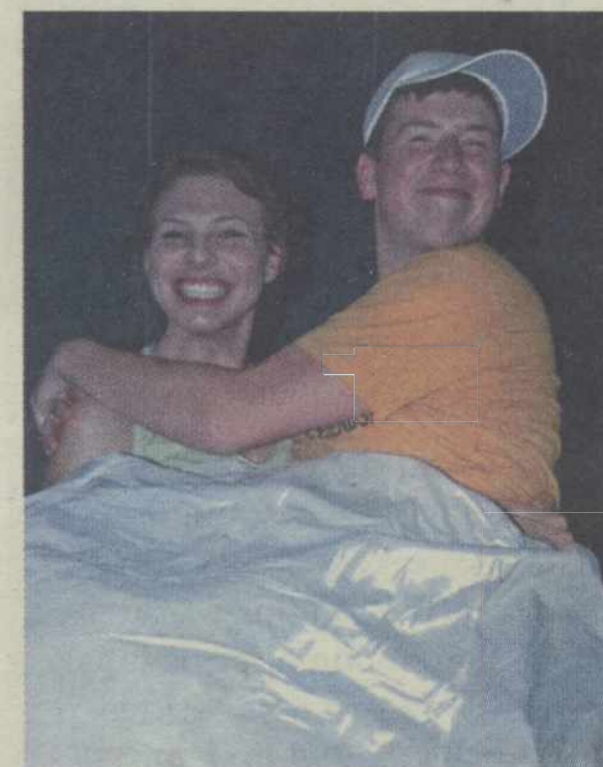
If I were a shoe brand I would

I guess Nike...cuz my mini shocks are my favorite! They're really cute!

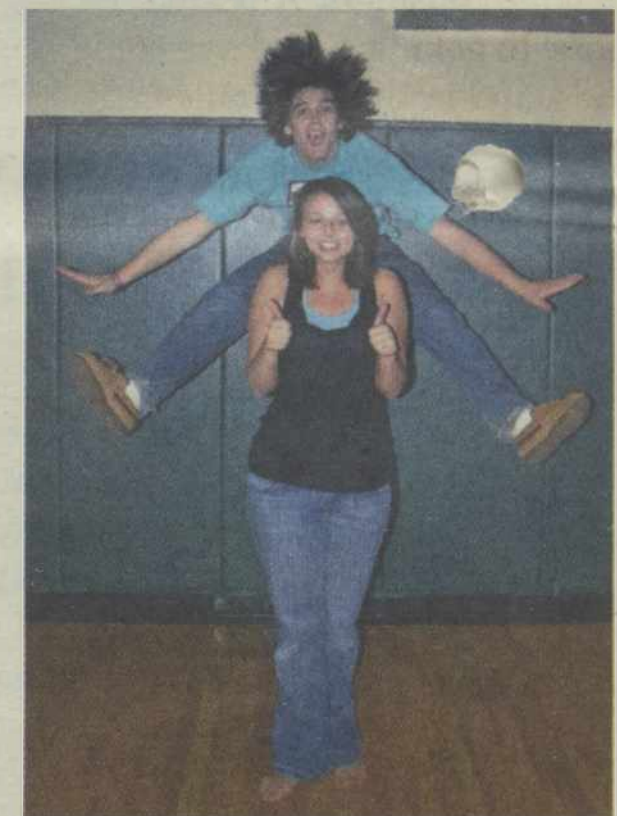
### Joseph Lewis
