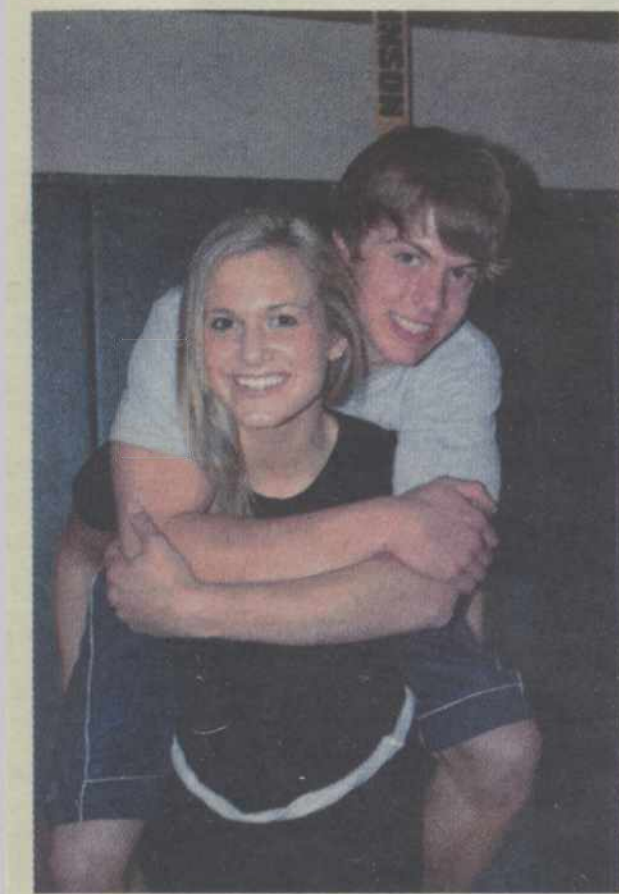

that I can eventually become a wedding planner.

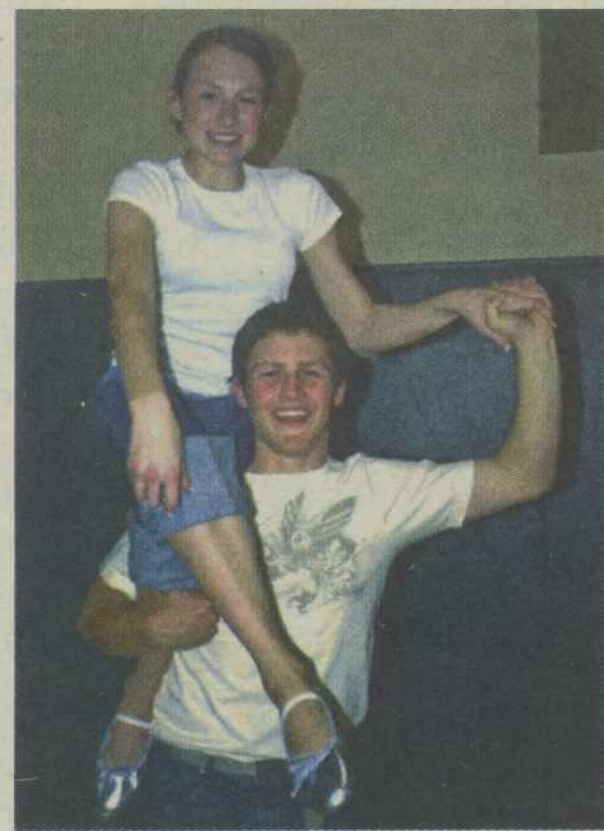

What is your favorite high school memory?

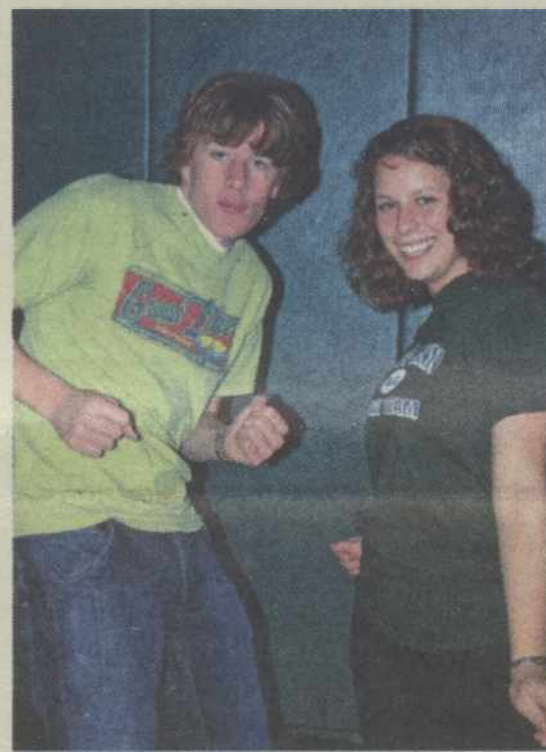
My favorite high school memory is how all my friends and I have stuck through the hard times all
