

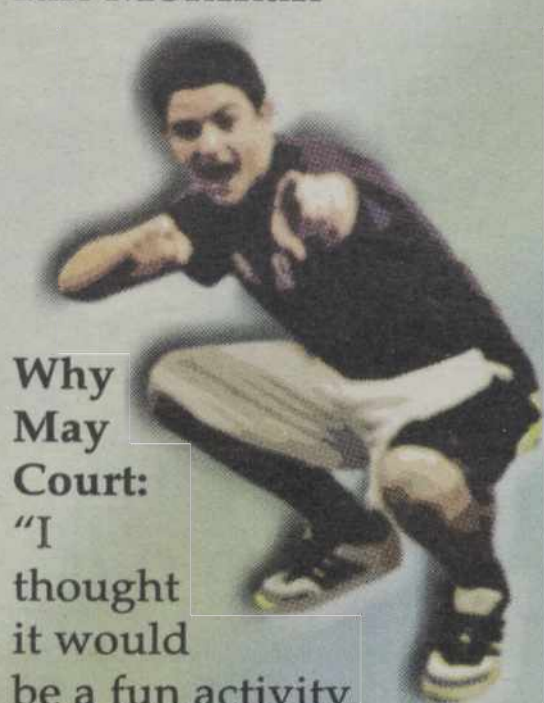
Seniors dance music spring

Why May Court: "I thought it would be a fun activity outside of school."

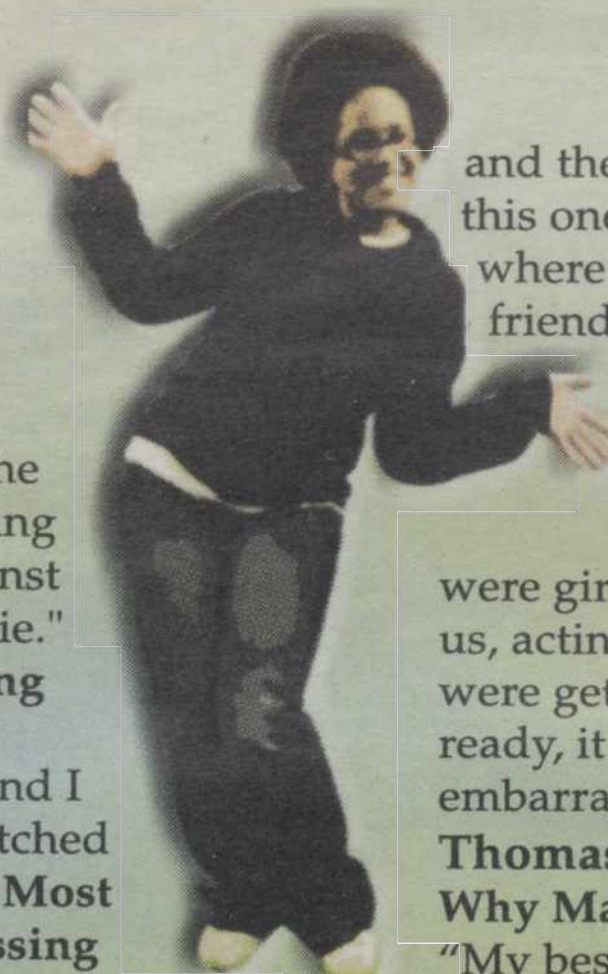

Why May Court: "It looked like fun."

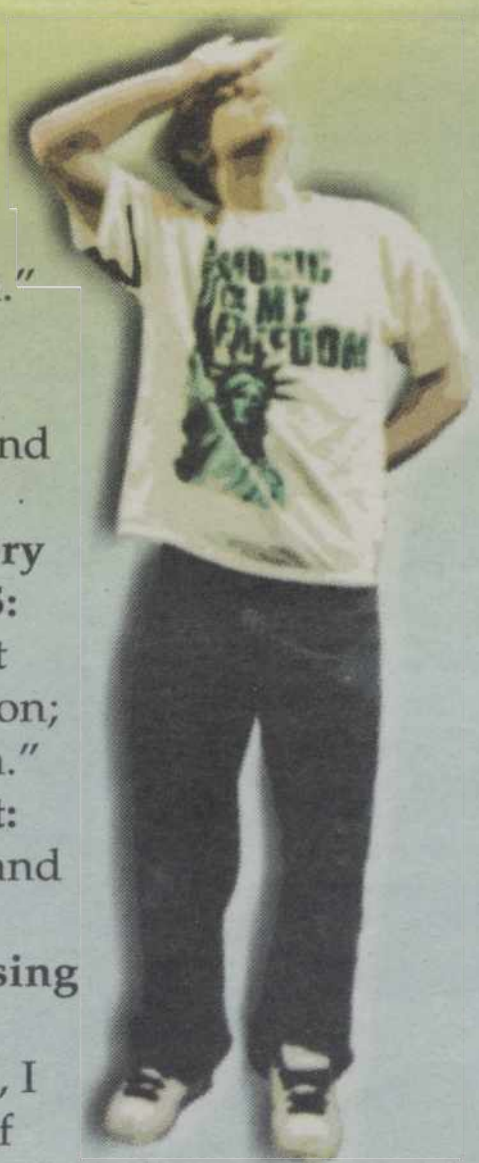
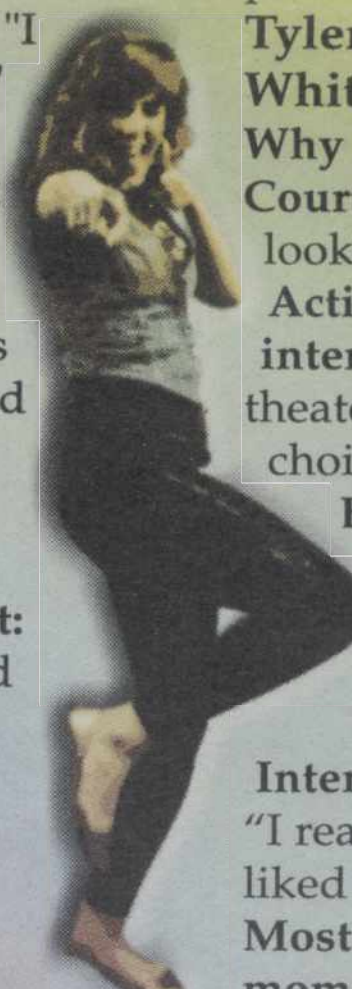
