### Strike ends with new agreement at Golf Channel

Some pretty crummy video went out on the Golf Channel in mid-January, as managers scrambled to operate cameras and other equipment. But after 11 days, the 350 freelance broadcast technicians represented by IATSE were back to work with a new two-year contract that the union said increases employer health insurance contributions and brings wages "closer to industry standard rates." IATSE credited IBEW and NABET-CWA for honoring picket lines.
