Nominees must be present to accept, or have written acceptance of nomination submitted at this meeting. Nominations will be held in accordance with Article VII, Sections 1-4 and Article XI, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Office & Professional Employees International Union, Local No. 11.

As provided by our Constitution, no person may be nominated, appointed or elected, unless he or she has been a member of this Union in continuous good standing for at least 12 months preceding the election.

No member shall be a candidate for more than one office.

Those members, who by virtue of geography are unable to either attend or have other members from their area attend to place their name in nomination, may notify the Union office of their desire to be nominated. The Executive Secretary Treasurer shall nominate or cause to be nominated those same members. The members, who are not present at the nomination meeting to accept the nomination, must have their acceptance of the nomination in writing, available at the nomination meeting. Only those candidates who accept the nomination shall be considered valid candidates. [Only members that reside outside of Multnomah, Clackamas and Washington Counties in Oregon, and Clark County in Washington may utilize the geographical exception above.]

Except as provided for above, write-in nominations or nominations by proxy shall not be allowed.
