A cannery strike comes to life

It was one of the most remarkable strikes of the 1980s: A thousand frozen food workers in Watsonville, California struck for 18 months — and won in an era of union-busting. Now the story comes to the stage in a play by Cherríe Moraga, based on interviews she conducted with residents of Watsonville. *Watsonville: Some Place Not Here* will have a three-week run at Portland's Milagro Theater.

Stamp Out Hunger food drive

Portland-area letter carriers will “Stamp Out Hunger” once again, as part of the 26th annual National Association of Letter Carriers food drive. Letter carriers deliver plastic bags to every

household a few days before May 11. All you have to do is fill the bag with nonperishable food items, and leave it at your mailbox on the morning of May 11. Letter Carriers collect the bags and deliver them to drop points, where volunteers sort the donations and forward them to the Oregon Food Bank. Food collected in Clark County will benefit Clark County hunger-relief agencies. It's the largest one-day food collection of the year.
