Inside the West Virginia teachers' strike

When West Virginia teachers went on strike in February, they shut down every public school in the state. Nine school days later, the strike ended with a significant raise for all public sector workers, the withdrawal of bills to expand charter schools and eliminate teacher seniority, and a promise to convene a task force to find ways to rein in health care costs. Their victory inspired teacher strikes in Oklahoma, Kentucky, and Arizona. Now, one of the strike leaders is coming to Portland to talk about how the strike was organized and won.
