Labor-management conference to explore future of work

The Oregon chapter of the Labor and Employment Relations Association (LERA) will hold its annual conference Thursday, Nov. 15, at the World Trade Center, 121 SW Salmon St., Portland, followed by the Maggie Awards ceremony and reception. The awards program recognizes individuals from labor, management, academics and neutrals who have made major contributions to labor-management relations.

This year's conference, "Shaping the Future of Work," will feature a keynote presenta-

tion by Tom Kochan, professor at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology's Sloan School of Management, and co-director of the Institute for Work and Employment Research. Kochan has long advocated the need to update the nation's employment policies, practices and institutions to mutually benefit workers, families, companies and broad-based prosperity in a changing workplace.
