



A CALL TO ACTION TO SUPPORT JORDAN COVE

The Jordan Cove Project anticipates receiving all necessary authorizations by the end of 2019 to allow construction to begin in early 2020. As part of that process, local, state, and federal agencies will be holding public meetings in the first half of 2019.

The Oregon Department of State Lands will hold the first of these meetings in early January to solicit comments on the Jordan Cove Project's Removal-Fill permit application.

Jordan Cove will create more than 6,000 good-paying construction jobs during the peak period of construction, along with adding an estimated 8,500 jobs in supported industries. The Project will bring \$10 billion in private capital to Oregon, one of the largest-ever private investments in Oregon's history. This includes \$60 million dollars in new tax revenue for Southern Oregon and the South Coast every year to invest in schools and services.
