Scavenger hunt teaches kids about unions (and they might win a bike)

A scavenger hunt for children ages 1 to 18 will be presented by Labor's Community Service Agency (LCSA). Participants will use clues found in a "passport" to find various unions at the picnic. For example, a clue might be: "We are the union that delivers your mail six days a week." Answer: National Association of Letter Carriers. Participants must find the NALC picnic site (look for signage) and have their passports stamped there.

For out-of-work union families: Free food and drink at the picnic

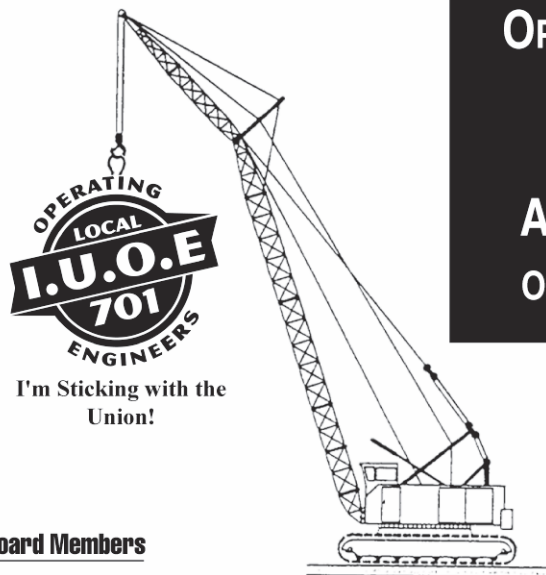
