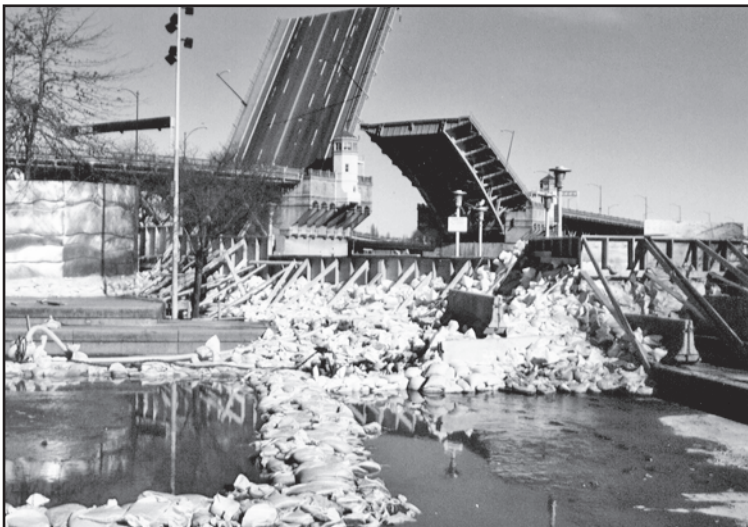

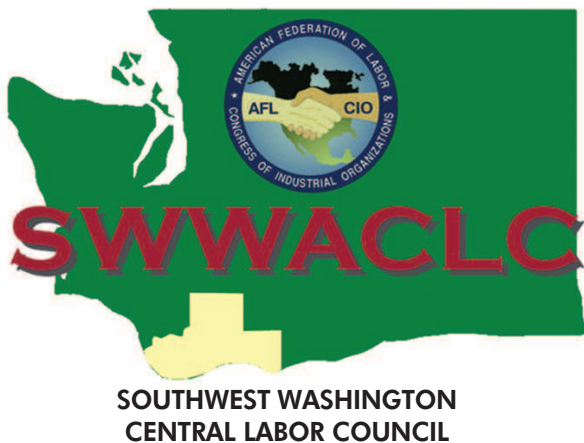

ATU and Greyhound end bitter three-year strike.
