Workers Helping Workers

Next food distribution event will be March 14 at Laborers Local 737 hall

Workers Helping Workers will hold its fourth food distribution for union families and others hit hard by the COVID-19 pandemic Sunday, March 14, from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the Laborers Local 737 Training Center, 17230 NE Sacramento St, Portland.

Oregon's unions joined together shortly after the pandemic hit in February 2020 to create the Workers Helping Workers food drive and distribution program. More than 30 unions and labor councils have contributed financially and with volunteers, who sort food, box it, and hand it out.

Workers Helping Workers has held three distributions since June 2020, and has handed out more than 3,000 food boxes that are filled with canned goods,



bread, and fresh fruits and vegetables.

Food boxes are available for workers who have seen their hours cut, their jobs furloughed or ended, or have experienced increased medical bills. The food, hospitality and entertainment industries have been particularly hard hit, with some union locals experiencing nearly 100% unemployment. You don't have to be a union member to get a box of food.

Union volunteers are needed to

help sort, box, and hand out food for the March 14 distribution. Sorting and packing will take place on Thursday, March 11, Friday, March 12, and Saturday, March 13 at Local 737. For more information or to sign up, go to workers-helpingworkers.com. Due to the pandemic, there is a limit to the number of volunteers that can be on site at one time.
