Michael Burch, community relations representative for the Pacific Northwest Regional Council of Carpenters, was appointed to a four-year term on the Oregon State Apprenticeship and Training Council.

John Scanlan, a Pendleton

middle school language arts teacher and board member of the Oregon Education Association, was appointed to a seat on the Public Employees Retirement Board, and **Siobhan Martin**, deputy executive director of Service Employees International Union Local 503, was reappointed.
