Brett's Blue House Brews created some fantastic summer concoctions including a Raspberry Rye that is both refreshing and flavorful. Our favorite close to home taste of the Mediterranean just got a little bit better.

Deschutes Brewery Reserve Series - WOW!! The folks at Deschutes Brewery are at it again. Continuing in the tradition of The Abyss, that wonderfully huge Stout they've released the last few years, comes Black Butte XX, a tribute to Black Butte Porter. A limited released on June 27th, it is a colossal version of the original, enhanced with chocolate and coffee, then aged in whiskey barrels. At 11% alcohol by volume, this one would have knocked my socks off had I been wearing any. Next up: The Dissident, a distinctive Oud Bruin, Flanders-style brown ale, scheduled to be released on September 1st. This one also weighs in at 11% ABV and uses a wild yeast strain called Brettanomyces (also known as Brett) during eighteen months of fermentation. It is also aged in pinot and cabernet barrels for over 3 months and includes Central Washington cherries for flavor. All I can say is WOW!


Joel: "How about the scene in 'One Flew over the Cuckoo's Nest' when they sneak out and go deep sea fishing."


