Because of poor drainage in the area, the flood waters didn't recede as they did everywhere else in town, and for days the family, unable to return to their home, was left wondering what kind of damage they would find. When they did return, they had to throw away almost everything.

The family stayed with friends for the first month and then borrowed a trailer for another.


Eventually they bought a trailer that they could live in on their property while working on their home. Meanwhile the Clever Cricket sat and waited. Throughout the spring and summer the Eyrricks worked to put their lives back together. "We received so much help - from the Christian Aid groups that came to town to help, from friends, from the State Prison Inmates, even from total strangers," said Eyrrick. "A contractor from Forest Grove, Mark Dawson, came out as a volunteer and helped us

muck out our house. He left his business pick-up truck for us to use to haul away garbage. We had never met him before, and he left us his truck!"

The Eyrrick's are now back in their home ten months after the flood. "It has been a great learning experience," said Eyrrick, always the optimist. "We're survivors."

In the meantime, Eyrrick's husband Brandon was diagnosed with a Chiari Type I Malformation, a not uncommon birth defect. Brandon's skull is too small for his brain, and he began suffering unusual side effects and symptoms. He underwent successful surgery at the end of September and was scheduled to come home from the hospital at press time.

As for The Clever Cricket, it, too, is a survivor. The family has decided to pursue the shop more as a business and try to make a real go of it. They will keep more regular hours and will be reworking their website so customers can shop online. Her kids, "...a couple of smarty
