Coming to America, Charles came first to Scofield, Oregon then to Vernonia where he attended school.

He was united in marriage to Dessie Irene May on July 1, 1941 in Vancouver, Washington. Following their marriage they resided in Vernonia community, where Charles worked first in the woods on a rigging crew, and then went to work at the Oregon American Lumber Co. mill until its closure in 1957. He then drove fork
