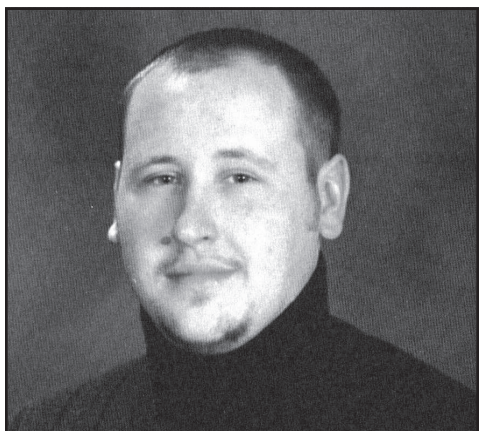


In Memory of...
