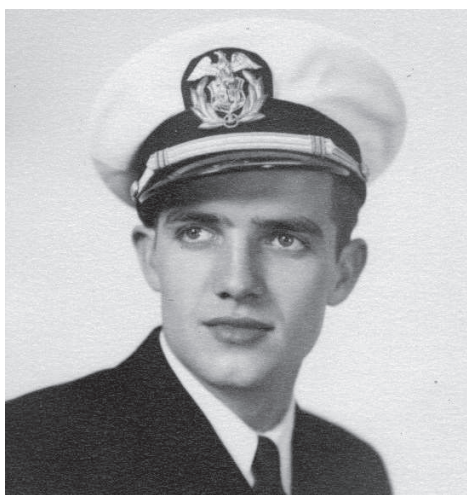

CLOICE LESLIE HALL, 89, a resident of the Portland community, died Wednesday morning, June 27, 2012, at St. Vincent Hospital in Portland, Oregon.

Cloice Leslie Hall was born February 18, 1923, in Battleground, Washington, the son of the late Charles "Les" and Edith Bagby Hall. He moved to Vernonia with his family when he was a boy, where he was raised and received his education. Shortly after graduating high school, Cloice joined the Merchant Marines and served as a Naval Officer in World War II.

Cloice worked in the logging industry; owned and operated a commercial long haul truck; and, owned and operated a successful excavation business.

Following their retirement, they moved to Louisiana, where they lived for fifteen years. In 2009, they moved back to Portland, where they have resided since.
