worked with architects to develop a cost effective new building that is designed to be Leeds Platinum certified. He also oversaw the remodeling of the new District Office.

Cox helped create a Natural Resources curriculum, changing the way natural science is taught in all the schools. The program features Forestry Studies and teaches students about the natural environment that surrounds the Vernonia community.

In August of 2012 Cox was center stage for the grand opening of the new Vernonia Schools campus, proudly sharing the lectern that day with Kulongoski, US Senators Jeff Merkley and Ron Wyden, US Congresswoman Suzanne Bonamici, Oregon State Senator Betsy Johnson, and others. "There were a lot of people who never thought this day would come," said Cox at the grand opening ceremony. "I was reminded this past week of someone who said it was just a dream. Ladies and gentleman, behold the dream!"

the new school Cox directed the deconstruction of the old school campus as well as the start of the construction of days,

the new Spencer Park at the old school site.

In May of 2013, with the Vernonia School District facing tough budget constraints, Cox agreed to retire from his position and was then immediately re-hired at half time, saving the District thousands of dollars in benefits and salary costs.

On Thursday, June 5, 2014, in one of his final acts as Superintendent of the Vernonia School district Cox presided over the official School Dedication, as the District unveiled plaques that honor donors, others who were instrumental in the construction

of the school campus and the School Board. As part of the Dedication ceremony Cox was celebrated by having the school computer lab named in his honor.
