Mary "Lorraine" Borst passed peacefully the morning of September 14th, 2014 at her home in Vernonia, just one week after celebrating her 80th Birthday amongst family and friends.

Lorraine was born on September 11th, 1934 in Akra, North Dakota to Edith and John Crowston. She was the only girl of 7 children and helped raise her brothers after her Daddy's death when she was 12 years old. Being the only girl, she and her brothers were very close – the pride and love she had for them and their Crowston name was well known.

Lorraine was active in school sports including, track, twirling, cheer leading, basketball and was once a May Day Queen. Lorraine's education was temporarily postponed at 17, when she married Jack Odam. Soon

followed the birth of 3 baby girls Mary Anne, Jackie and Kathy – she resumed and completed her education when the oldest started school. After the girls were raised, Jack and Lorraine went their separate ways continuing their friendship throughout their years.
