

Designed and funded through the second most funded project in Kickstarter's food category, uKeg generated 10,293 backers who pledged \$1.5 million to manufacture this new product.



The engineers at GrowlerWerks who designed the uKeg have created a stainless-steel and brass 64 ounce container which will sell for \$119 complete with vacuum sealed insulation, a bar styled tap handle, and innovative carbonation system. A 128 ounce version is also available.

Taps Around Town- Now that winter is officially here, you may want to stay a little closer to home to enjoy your favorite beverage.

The All In Pub and Eatery has eight beers



on tap right here in Vernonia, five of them currently dedicated to Oregon craft beers. Leading the line up is Deschutes Black Butte Porter along with Deschutes Red Chair Northwest Pale Ale. Next in line is Eugene's Hop Valley Alpha Centauri Imperial IPA, a big,

hoppy beer that the bartenders all say has been very popular. The old stand-by, Widmer Hefeweisen is next, and the list is rounded out with Full Sail's Cascade Pilsner

It's a pretty good mix of brews to go along with one of the All In's famous burgers, fries or one of their daily specials. Make sure you stop in and give them a try.



Consider all of the conditions before you drive this winter.

• Weather conditions. Check a weather website, such as www.weather.gov/forecasts/graphical/sectors/pacnorthwest. php, for driving conditions to help you decide when and if to hit the road, cross the mountains or go into the city.

• Road conditions. Oregon Department of Transportation continually updates www.tripcheck.org with road and weather conditions, construction zones and camera views.

• Your car's condition. How are your tires? Do you have chains? You should also be prepared with emergency supplies, a full tank of gas and a charged cell phone so you can call 9-1-1 in an emergency.

• Your own condition. Have you had enough rest? Or a few drinks? Honestly assess your own ability to drive safely before you get behind the wheel in winter's more challenging driving conditions.
