"It is really great to see all the campuses come together and become one big family," says Faith's marketing director Eddie Kirkpatrick. "As you talk to students and faculty at Faith there is an excitement and ongoing anticipation about all the things God is doing."

Kirkpatrick added that financial aid is available to qualifying families so that every student has an opportunity to receive their education from a Biblical worldview. The objective of FBCS is to train up children in the way they should go and to serve others in their community.
