- A panel coordinator program, to help ensure that medical clinics are providing patients with the services they need to be healthy.
- Free SafeLink cellular phones and phone service for OHP members, allowing them to access their health care providers easily and get text messages designed to encourage healthy behaviors.

In 2016, the CCO will focus increased efforts on improving drug and alcohol screening and treatment. It also will focus on improving blood pressure and diabetic blood sugar control. And, the CCO will increase awareness of preventive services, and encourage members to seek care from health care and dental providers to help OHP members be as healthy as possible.
