Nancy Elizabeth Elliott, 73, of Portland, passed away February 23, 2016, from natural causes after a nine-year battle with cancer.

Nancy was born July 24, 1942 in Eugene, the only daughter of Herb and Edna Gaskill. She grew up on the family farm with a kid goat, Nellie, as her pet. Graduating from North Eugene High School in 1960,

Nancy then earned her undergraduate degree from the University of Oregon in 1964. She became one of the first women to participate in a business exchange program with Finland in 1963 and brought home a love of Scandinavian design. After earning her M.B.A. graduate degree from Portland State University in 1985, she became active in education and earned her superintendent's certificate in 1996.

Nancy was married to David in 1965. The couple moved to Portland and had two sons, Stephen (1969) and Christopher (1973). Devoted to her family and friends, Nancy hosted summer visitors from England and Finland, volunteered as a Cub Scout leader and was active with the PTA at the boys' school.

Her career culminated as the director of education and special education for the North Coast Youth Correctional Facility in Warrenton, where she helped to positively change the lives of many youths and offered them hope through learning in a supportive environment.

How to Avoid the Flu

Get the seasonal flu vaccine

- The majority of flu is spread by young, healthy, unvaccinated children and
- Flu vaccine is recommended for people 6 months and older. Flu vaccine finder: flu.oregon.gov.

Stay home if you get sick

Prevent spread to others

Wash your hands often

- Use soap and warm water. Wash for 15 to 20 seconds.
- If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- If the hand sanitizer is a gel, rub your hands until the gel is dry.

Take everyday precautions

- · Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue or your arm when you cough or
- Try to avoid close contact with sick people.
- Clean work and household surfaces often.
- Wear a mask in public if you have a weakened immune system.
- Ask your family, friends and health providers to get a flu vaccination.
- Practice good health habits. Get plenty of sleep and exercise, manage your stress, drink plenty of fluids, and eat healthy foods.
