ODFW Fishing Regs, Discuss Cougar Plan *continued from page 13*

in 2006, the Plan guides management of cougars in Oregon. The draft updated Plan incorporates new scientific literature and Oregon-specific research about cougars, including a genetics and habitat analysis, but does not propose major management changes. The updated Plan will continue to stress coexistence with Oregon's more than 6,000 cougars.

The Commission will be asked to approve grant funds for nine Restoration and Enhancement Projects to improve angler access or facilities or enhance fisheries.

Finally, the Com-

mission is expected to appoint a Landowner Representative to the Access and Habitat Board, which provides grants for projects that improve hunter access or wildlife habitat on private land.
