Overall Snow was pleasantly surprised with the results of the show and the feedback from his audience. "We got a lot of comments from the show and we expect it to double or more by next year," said Snow.

He said people really liked the unique judging system which did not include classes. Instead judges grade each car on a scale of 1 to 10, regardless of what it is. "If a ride hits a 7.5 on the scale, we put it in a group of 7.5s and debate on the winner. Makes it equal for everyone," said Snow.

Up for grabs were ten "Best Ten of Ten" awards and three

hand built awards. Jeffrey Crouse of Scappoose took home the "Grand Rat Award."

Another twist this year was the addition of the "350 Smallblock Tear-



down & Rebuild" contest. Local Vernonian Matt Poetter was the winner over Scott Ross of Clatskanie by 9/10 of a second and walked away with the \$250 grand prize sponsored by Louis Lardy's Mechanic Shop.
