## **Schools Update: Budget Committee**

Citizens interested in serving on the the Vernonia School District (VSD) Budget Committee are needed to fill three open positions. Budget Committee Members will review the upcoming 2018-19 proposed school budget, and provide recommendations to the School Board for approval. Budget Committee positions are filled through application and appointment by the VSD Board of Directors for a three-year term. Public involvement in the school budget process is mandated by law.

Budget Committee Members are responsible for reviewing the proposed budget and assuring it is balanced, receiving public comment, and providing input and feedback at official meetings that will be held throughout the spring. This year's meetings are scheduled for May 3 and 10. The Board will take action to adopt the Budget Committee approved document at their June 14 meeting.

The Committee must keep in mind the budget goals of the District which include providing the necessary instructional resources to ensure student success, maintaining safe and healthy physical facilities that provide a quality learning experience, and offering professional development opportunities for all employees when reviewing the over \$6 million budget.

Through their work the Budget Committee can recommend revisions to the budget, if needed, and will approve a budget for adoption by the VSD School

Board. The adopted budget becomes the basic short-term operational plan and fiscal guideline for the VSD Board of Directors and the administrative staff for the 2018-19 fiscal year.
