My work with local economic development is attracting new businesses and helping local businesses grow and thrive. We're establishing the world-class OMIC advanced manufacturing research center and a PCC campus in Scappoose. We've helped existing businesses like Teevin Brothers, Rightline Equipment, and Cascades Tissue expand. Adding businesses reduces the tax burden on residents while improving services available.

Improving Livability

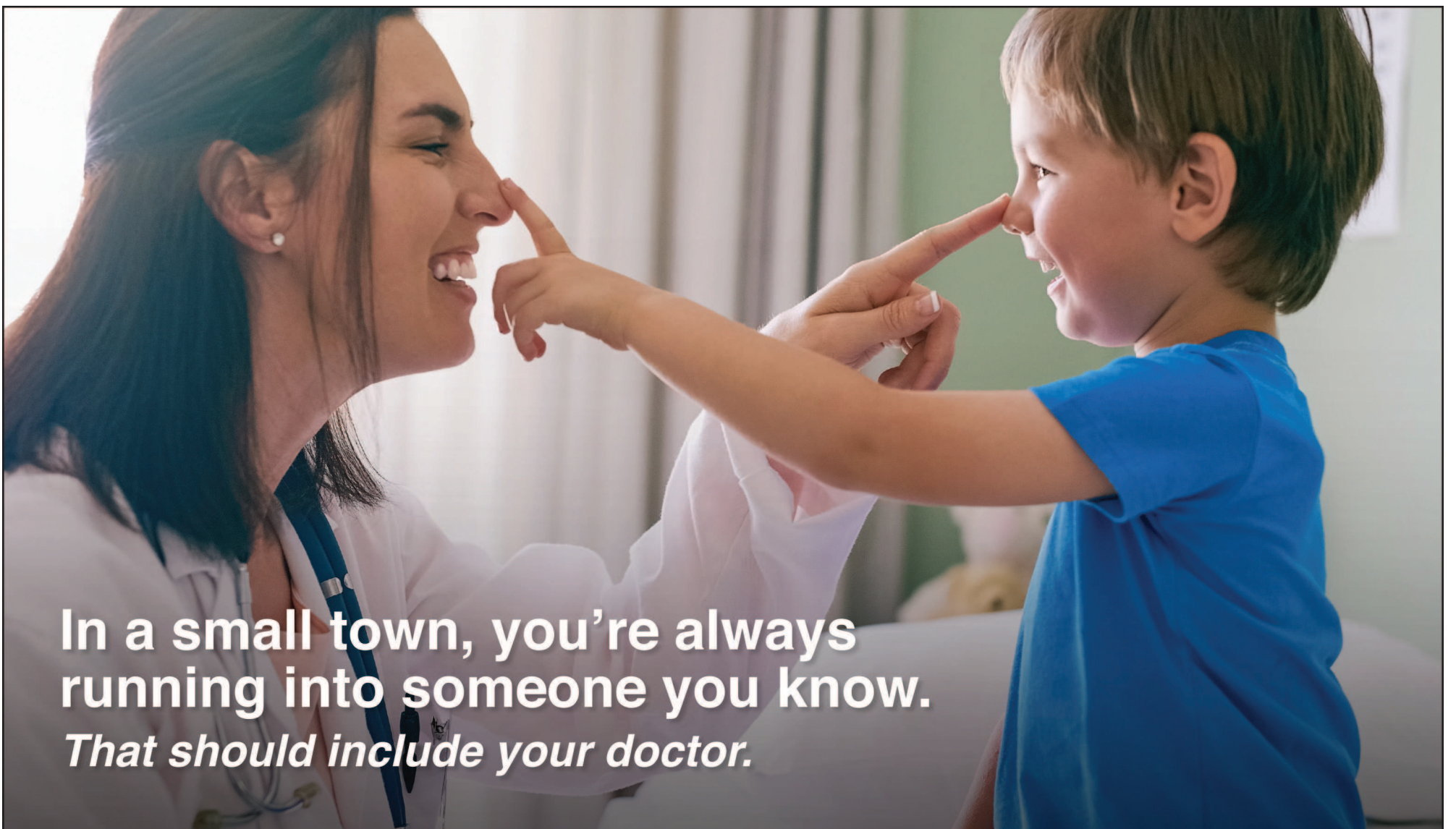
